A RESOLUTION

- Designating September 25, 2019, as "Someone You Know Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Opioid addiction has reached epidemic proportions
- 4 across the country; and
- 5 WHEREAS, With the nation's third highest death rate due to
- 6 drug overdose, Pennsylvania is a microcosm for the opioid crisis
- 7 affecting families nationally; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Stigma is recognized as a barrier to people seeking
- 9 help and treatment for opioid use disorder; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Experts agree that sharing positive stories of
- 11 people who have been affected by opioid use disorders is an
- 12 effective strategy to address social stigma; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Recognizing the need to address this epidemic, the
- 14 Independence Blue Cross Foundation launched "Someone You Know"
- 15 to share diverse stories of hope for those who have found a life
- 16 in recovery, supported a loved one with opioid addiction or

- 1 sadly lost a loved one to an overdose; and
- 2 WHEREAS, "Someone You Know" began as a regional public health
- 3 awareness campaign involving nearly a dozen participants and a
- 4 national conference that convened more than 600 leaders in
- 5 health, government and communities, including the United States
- 6 Surgeon General; and
- 7 WHEREAS, In one year, the diversity and number of "Someone
- 8 You Know" participants increased to 20 ambassadors who have
- 9 shared their stories at three major events in 2019, engaging
- 10 Federal and state legislators at day long exhibitions in
- 11 Washington, DC, Harrisburg and Philadelphia; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Each event featured an interactive mobile display
- 13 for guests to listen to the stories of hope told by campaign
- 14 participants; and
- 15 WHEREAS, The mobile exhibit was created to expand the reach
- 16 of initial advertising and travels to community events, colleges
- 17 and corporate campuses; and
- 18 WHEREAS, "Someone You Know" has gained national attention for
- 19 addressing the stigma of opioid use disorder; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Through regional advertising, social media promotion
- 21 and the mobile exhibit, "Someone You Know" generated more than
- 22 40 million viewer impressions and more than 85,000 views of
- 23 videos to date; and
- 24 WHEREAS, On September 25, 2019, the "Someone You Know" mobile
- 25 exhibit is traveling to the State Capitol to raise awareness
- 26 about the Independence Blue Cross Foundation's grassroots public
- 27 health campaign that is breaking the stigma of opioid addiction,
- 28 inspiring hope and empowering others to seek help and treatment;
- 29 therefore be it
- 30 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate

1 September 25, 2019, as "Someone You Know Day" in Pennsylvania.
