A RESOLUTION

1 Designating the week of May 3 through 9, 2020, as "Conservation  
2 District Week" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, Each county, except Philadelphia County, has a

7 there is enough clean water and healthy soil for the future; and

9 this Commonwealth are holding events which will include
