A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the week of November 15 through 22, 2020, as "Hunger  
2 and Homelessness Awareness Week" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, The National Coalition for the Homeless and the  
4 National Student Campaign Against Hunger and Homelessness  
5 sponsor "National Hunger and Homelessness Awareness Week" each  
6 year during the week prior to Thanksgiving; and

7 WHEREAS, The purpose of "National Hunger and Homelessness  
8 Awareness Week" is to educate the public about the many reasons  
9 people are hungry and homeless, including the shortage of  
10 affordable housing in this Commonwealth for very low-income  
11 residents, and encourage support for homeless assistance service  
12 providers as well as community service opportunities for  
13 students and school service organizations; and

14 WHEREAS, Coordinated activities take place during this week  
15 to promote education, service and action domestically and  
16 internationally with the aim of ending hunger and homelessness

1 and strengthening individuals and communities; and

2 WHEREAS, The House of Representatives recognizes that hunger  
3 and homelessness continue to be serious problems for many  
4 families and individuals in this Commonwealth; therefore be it

5 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the  
6 week of November 15 through 22, 2020, as "Hunger and  
7 Homelessness Awareness Week" in Pennsylvania and urge  
8 Pennsylvanians to gain a greater awareness of the problems of  
9 hunger and homelessness in their communities and this  
10 Commonwealth.
