A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing October 5, 2020, as "World Habitat Day" in
2 Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, Since its founding in 1976, Habitat for Humanity has
4 helped more than 13.2 million people around the world improve
5 their living conditions; and

6 WHEREAS, The organization is a nonprofit, ecumenical
7 Christian ministry founded on the conviction that every man,
8 woman and child should have a decent, safe and affordable place
9 to live; and

10 WHEREAS, The houses built offer simple, decent and affordable
11 homes to low-income families around the world; and

12 WHEREAS, Habitat for Humanity is needed to help eliminate
13 poverty by providing shelter to those in need; and

14 WHEREAS, Families left homeless by natural disasters, war and
15 civil unrest often face dire housing situations as they struggle
16 to rebuild their lives; and

1 WHEREAS, Habitat for Humanity's Disaster Response programs
2 provide shelter and housing solutions to help these families
3 recover; therefore be it

4 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize October
5 5, 2020, as "World Habitat Day" in Pennsylvania; and be it
6 further

7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives acknowledge
8 Habitat for Humanity for their outstanding contribution toward
9 the easing of suffering and the rebuilding of individual and
10 family lives on "World Habitat Day" 2020.
