## AN ACT

- Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in registration of vehicles, further providing for
- yeteran plates and placard.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 1342(a) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 1342. Veteran plates and placard.
- 9 (a) Severely disabled veteran plate. -- On the application of
- 10 a veteran whose service-connected disability is certified at
- 11 [100%] 75% or greater by the service unit of the armed forces in
- 12 which the veteran served or by the United States Veterans'
- 13 Administration or who has a service-connected disability of the
- 14 type enumerated in section 1338 (relating to person with
- 15 disability plate and placard), the department shall issue a
- 16 special registration plate designating the vehicle as belonging
- 17 to a severely disabled veteran. The registration plate shall

- 1 have a white background, shall have blue numbers or letters as
- 2 the department may determine, shall have the words "disabled
- 3 veteran" in at least ten-point bold type inscribed in red at the
- 4 bottom of the plate and shall include the international symbol
- 5 for access for persons with disabilities. A special registration
- 6 plate issued to a veteran under this section may be used only on
- 7 a passenger car or truck with a registered gross weight of not
- 8 more than 14,000 pounds. In the case of a motorcycle, the
- 9 department shall issue a decal containing the international
- 10 symbol for access for persons with disabilities and the words
- 11 "disabled veteran" for display on the registration plate.

- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
