AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, in registration of vehicles, further providing for
3 veteran plates and placard.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 1342(a) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 1342. Veteran plates and placard.

9 (a) Severely disabled veteran plate.--On the application of
10 a veteran whose service-connected disability is certified at
11 [100%] 75% or greater by the service unit of the armed forces in
12 which the veteran served or by the United States Veterans'
13 Administration or who has a service-connected disability of the
14 type enumerated in section 1338 (relating to person with
15 disability plate and placard), the department shall issue a
16 special registration plate designating the vehicle as belonging
17 to a severely disabled veteran. The registration plate shall

1 have a white background, shall have blue numbers or letters as
2 the department may determine, shall have the words "disabled
3 veteran" in at least ten-point bold type inscribed in red at the
4 bottom of the plate and shall include the international symbol
5 for access for persons with disabilities. A special registration
6 plate issued to a veteran under this section may be used only on
7 a passenger car or truck with a registered gross weight of not
8 more than 14,000 pounds. In the case of a motorcycle, the
9 department shall issue a decal containing the international
10 symbol for access for persons with disabilities and the words
11 "disabled veteran" for display on the registration plate.

13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
