 petition.

General rule.--[An] No ordinance may [not] be passed and 3 (a) [a] <u>no</u> petition may [not] be filed for the election of a 4 government study commission pursuant to section 2911 (relating 5 to submission of question for election of government study 6 commission) while proceedings are pending under any other 7 petition or ordinance filed or passed under the authority of 8 this subpart nor [on the same question if it has been defeated] 9 10 within four years after an election has been held pursuant to any such ordinance or petition passed or filed under section 11 2911 in which the question was defeated. 12
