## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Titles 51 (Military Affairs) and 74 (Transportation) of
- the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in Department of
- 3 Military Affairs, providing for Civil Air Patrol; and, in
- 4 authority of Department of Transportation, further providing
- for authority of department.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Title 51 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 9 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 10 § 713. Civil Air Patrol.
- 11 (a) Liaison. -- The department shall be a liaison for the
- 12 Civil Air Patrol and shall, notwithstanding any law, provide
- 13 administrative support in accordance with this section and
- 14 within the limits of authorized appropriations.
- 15 (b) Supervision. -- The department shall:
- 16 (1) Receive and supervise the expenditure of State funds
- 17 appropriated by the General Assembly or secured by the
- 18 <u>Commonwealth for the use and benefit of the Civil Air Patrol</u>
- 19 within this Commonwealth.

- 1 (2) Supervise the maintenance and use of Commonwealth
- 2 facilities used by the Civil Air Patrol.
- 3 (3) Receive, from the Commonwealth or the Commonwealth's
- 4 <u>instrumentalities</u>, requests for approval for assistance by
- 5 the Civil Air Patrol in natural or man-made disasters or
- 6 <u>emergency situations. A requested and approved mission must</u>
- 7 <u>be approved or denied in accordance with Federal procedures</u>
- 8 <u>and in consultation with the Adjutant General or the Adjutant</u>
- 9 General's designee and the Pennsylvania Emergency Management
- 10 Agency.
- 11 (c) Construction. -- Nothing in this section may be construed
- 12 to limit, diminish or impair an authority, right or agreement
- 13 <u>validly established and existing on the effective date of this</u>
- 14 <u>section</u>.
- 15 (d) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following
- 16 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 17 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 18 "Assistance." The term shall include, but is not limited to,
- 19 the following missions:
- 20 (1) Search and rescue.
- 21 (2) Disaster relief support.
- 22 (3) Homeland security.
- 23 (4) Emergency transport services.
- 24 (5) Communications support.
- 25 Section 2. Section 5301(b)(5) of Title 74 is repealed:
- 26 § 5301. Authority of department.
- 27 \* \* \*
- 28 (b) Specific powers. -- The department is authorized to:
- 29 \* \* \*
- 30 [(5) Expend Commonwealth funds for search and rescue

- operations and organ transport by the civil air patrol, and
- 2 educational materials and equipment related thereto.]

- 4 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
