## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 62 (Procurement) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, in general provisions, further providing for
- definitions; and, in source selection and contract formation,
- further providing for competitive sealed bidding.

- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 103 of Title 62 of the Pennsylvania
- 8 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a definition to read:
- 9 § 103. Definitions.
- 10 Subject to additional definitions contained in subsequent
- 11 provisions of this part which are applicable to specific
- 12 provisions of this part, the following words and phrases when
- 13 used in this part shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 14 section unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:

- 16 "Local farm or food product." A product grown, processed,
- 17 packaged and distributed by a resident or business located
- 18 wholly within this Commonwealth.

- 2 Section 2. Section 512 of Title 62 is amended by adding a
- 3 subsection to read:
- 4 § 512. Competitive sealed bidding.
- 5 \* \* \*
- 6 (f.1) Locally sourced preference. -- Notwithstanding any other
- 7 provision of law, a qualified bidder on a State contract for the
- 8 purchase of food or a food product that agrees to perform the
- 9 contract using a local farm or food product may be given
- 10 preference over other bidders if the cost included in the bid
- 11 with a local farm or food product does not exceed more than 10%
- 12 of the bid amount of the lowest responsible bidder.

- 14 Section 3. The addition of 62 Pa.C.S. § 512(f.1) shall apply
- 15 to a bid submitted on or after the effective date of this
- 16 section.
- 17 Section 4. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
