AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in pupils and attendance, further 5 providing for age limits and temporary residence and for 6 definitions. 7 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Section 1301 of the act of March 10, 1949 11 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is
- 13 Section 1301. Age Limits; Temporary Residence.--Every child,
- 14 being a resident of any school district, between the ages of
- 15 [six (6)] five (5) and twenty-one (21) years on or before
- 16 <u>September 1 of the school term</u>, may attend the public schools in
- 17 his district, subject to the provisions of this act.
- 18 Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, a
- 19 child who attains the age of twenty-one (21) years during the
- 20 school term and who has not graduated from high school may

- 1 continue to attend the public schools in his district free of
- 2 charge until the end of the school term. The board of school
- 3 directors of any school district may admit to the schools of the
- 4 district, with or without the payment of tuition, any non-
- 5 resident child temporarily residing in the district, and may
- 6 require the attendance of such non-resident child in the same
- 7 manner and on the same conditions as it requires the attendance
- 8 of a resident child.
- 9 Section 2. The definition of "compulsory school age" in
- 10 section 1326 of the act is amended to read:
- 11 Section 1326. Definitions.--When used in this article, the
- 12 following words and phrases shall have the following meanings:
- 13 * * *
- "Compulsory school age" shall mean the period of a child's
- 15 life from the time the child's parents elect to have the child
- 16 enter school and which shall be no later than [eight (8)] five
- 17 (5) years of age on or before September 1 of the school term
- 18 until the child reaches seventeen (17) years of age. The term
- 19 does not include a child who holds a certificate of graduation
- 20 from a regularly accredited, licensed, registered or approved
- 21 high school.

- 23 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
