AN ACT

Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in rules of the road in general, further providing for additional parking regulations. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Additional parking regulations. 8 * * * 9 10 (b.1) Protected pedestrian plazas and pedalcycle lanes .--11 (1) When there is an on-street pedestrian plaza or a 12 pedalcycle lane adjacent to the right-hand curb of a two-way 13 or one-way highway, a vehicle standing or parked upon the 14 two-way or one-way highway shall be positioned in the 15 <u>direction of authorized traffic movement with the right-hand</u> 16 wheels of the vehicle parallel to and within 12 inches of the 17 outside line of the buffer area between the pedestrian plaza

- 1 (2) When there is an on-street pedestrian plaza or a pedalcycle lane adjacent to the left-hand curb of a one-way 2 or median-divided, two-way highway, a vehicle standing or 3 4 parked upon the highway shall be positioned in the direction of authorized traffic movement with the left-hand wheels of 5 6 the vehicle parallel to and within 12 inches of the outside line of the buffer area between the pedestrian plaza or 7 pedalcycle lane and parking. 8

- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
