AN ACT

1 Authorizing and directing the Department of General Services,
2 with the approval of the Governor, to grant and convey
3 certain lands and improvements situate in the City of
4 Allentown and the City of Bethlehem, Lehigh County, through a
5 competitive solicitation process; and making a related
6 repeal.

7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8 hereby enacts as follows:

9 Section 1. Conveyances in City of Allentown and City of
10 Bethlehem.

11 (a) Authorization.--The Department of General Services, with
12 the approval of the Governor, is authorized and directed on
13 behalf of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to grant and convey
14 the following tracts of land together with any improvements
15 thereon, known as the former Allentown State Hospital, situate
16 in the City of Allentown and City of Bethlehem, Lehigh County,
17 through a competitive solicitation for proposal process to
18 evaluate and select a buyer based upon best value and return on
19 investment, which, in addition to price, may include the
20 proposed use of the property, job creation, return to the

1 property tax rolls and other criteria specified in the
2 solicitation documents. A competitive solicitation committee
3 shall be established to review proposals and recommend a
4 buyer. The competitive solicitation committee shall be comprised
5 of the Secretary of General Services or their designee, the
6 member of the Senate in whose district the majority of the
7 property is located or their designee, the member of the House
8 of Representatives in whose district the majority of the
9 property is located or their designee and an official
10 representative of the municipality in which the majority of the
11 property is located or its designee.

12 (b) Property description.--The property to be conveyed under
13 subsection (a) consists of approximately 195.167 acres of land
14 and improvements located thereon, bounded and more particularly
15 described as follows:

21 BEING shown as Lot #2 on the Final Minor Subdivision Plan of
22 the Allentown State Hospital prepared by the City of Allentown
23 Department of Public Works, Drawing #06-005, dated July 20,
24 2007, last revised March 25, 2009.

25 (c) Condition precedent to property disposition.--Prior to
26 the competitive solicitation process under subsection (a) and
27 notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Department of
28 General Services is authorized and directed to demolish all
29 buildings and structures located on the property, with the
30 exception of a Commonwealth-owned air monitoring station,

1 utilizing funds appropriated in section 3(7)(ii)(A) of the act
2 of October 30, 2017 (P.L.831, No.52), known as the Capital
3 Budget Project Itemization Act of 2017-2018. The Department of
4 General Services shall use the competitive sealed proposal
5 method of procurement authorized by 62 Pa.C.S. § 513 (relating
6 to competitive sealed proposals) to enter into a design/build
7 contract to undertake the demolition of the buildings and
8 structures.

9 (d) Preemption of local ordinances.--The demolition of the
10 buildings and structures on the property and additional work
11 ancillary to the demolition of the buildings and structures on
12 the property by the Department of General Services are
13 authorized notwithstanding zoning ordinances, land use
14 ordinances, building codes or other regulations adopted or
15 enacted by a political subdivision under the authority of any
16 statute or under the authority of a charter or home rule charter
17 authorized and adopted under any statute or the Constitution of
18 Pennsylvania.

19 (e) Requirement for conveyance.--The conveyance shall be
20 made under and subject to all lawful and enforceable easements,
21 servitudes and rights of others, including, but not confined to,
22 streets, roadways and rights of any telephone, telegraph, water,
23 electric, gas or pipeline companies, as well as under and
24 subject to any lawful and enforceable estates or tenancies
25 vested in third persons appearing of record, for any portion of
26 the land or improvements erected thereon.

27 (f) Gaming restriction.--A conveyance authorized under this
28 section shall be made under and subject to the condition, which
29 shall be contained in the deed of conveyance, that no portion of
30 the property conveyed shall be used as a licensed facility, as

1 defined in 4 Pa.C.S. § 1103 (relating to definitions), or any
2 other similar type of facility authorized under State law. The
3 condition shall be a covenant running with the land and shall be
4 binding upon the grantee, its successors or assigns. Should the
5 grantee, its successors or assigns permit any portion of the
6 property authorized to be conveyed in this act to be used in
7 violation of this subsection, the title shall immediately revert
8 to and re-vest in the grantor.

9 (g) Covenants, conditions and restrictions.--The Secretary
10 of General Services may impose covenants, conditions,
11 restrictions or reservations on the sale of the property as is
12 deemed in the best interests of the Commonwealth.

13 (h) Easements.--The Secretary of General Services may grant
14 or retain any easements necessary to effectuate this section.

15 (i) Deed.--The conveyance shall be by special warranty deed
16 that shall be executed by the Secretary of General Services in
17 the name of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

18 (j) Proceeds.--All proceeds from the sale of the property
19 shall be deposited into the General Fund.

20 Section 2. Repeal.

21 Repeals are as follows:

22 (1) The General Assembly declares that the repeal under
23 paragraph (2) is necessary to effectuate section 1.

24 (2) Section 1 of the act of December 22, 2017 (P.L.1268,
25 No.82) entitled "An act authorizing and directing the
26 Department of General Services, with the approval of the
27 Governor, to grant and convey to TCA Properties, L.P.,
28 certain lands and improvements situate in the City of
29 Allentown and the City of Bethlehem, Lehigh County; and
30 authorizing the Department of General Services, with the

1 approval of the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs
2 and the Governor, to grant and convey, at a price to be
3 determined through a competitive bid process, certain lands,
4 buildings and improvements situate in the Borough of Kane,
5 McKean County," is repealed.

6 Section 3. Effective date.

7 This act shall take effect immediately.
