## AN ACT

- Amending the act of October 27, 1955 (P.L.744, No.222), entitled "An act prohibiting certain practices of discrimination 2 because of race, color, religious creed, ancestry, age or 3 national origin by employers, employment agencies, labor organizations and others as herein defined; creating the Pennsylvania Human Relations Commission in the Governor's 6 Office; defining its functions, powers and duties; providing 7 for procedure and enforcement; providing for formulation of 8 an educational program to prevent prejudice; providing for 9 10 judicial review and enforcement and imposing penalties," further providing for definitions. 11 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 13 hereby enacts as follows: 14 Section 1. Section 4 of the act of October 27, 1955 15 (P.L.744, No.222), known as the Pennsylvania Human Relations Act, is amended by adding clauses to read: 16 Section 4. Definitions. -- As used in this act unless a 17 18 different meaning clearly appears from the context: \* \* \* 19 20 (bb) The term "race" includes, but is not limited to, traits 21 historically associated with race, including, but not limited
- 2.2 to, hair texture and protective hairstyles.

- 1 (cc) The term "protective hairstyle" includes, but is not
- 2 <u>limited to, such hairstyles as braids, twists, locks, cornrows,</u>
- 3 coils and extensions.
- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
