Amending Titles 18 (Crimes and Offenses) and 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 2 Statutes, in minors, further providing for the offense of 3 sexual abuse of children AND PROVIDING FOR CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE <--PREVENTION TASK FORCE; and, in sentencing, further providing 5 for sentencing for offenses involving sexual abuse of 6 children. 7 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Section 6312(d.1) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 11 12 § 6312. Sexual abuse of children. * * * 13 (d.1) Grading. -- The offenses shall be graded as follows: 14 15 Except as provided in paragraph (3), an offense under subsection (b) is a felony of the second degree. 16 17 (2) (i) Except as provided in paragraph (3), a first 18 offense under subsection (c) or (d) is a felony of the third degree. 19 2.0 (ii) A second or subsequent offense under subsection

- 1 (c) or (d) is a felony of the second degree.

- 12 APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS MUST REFLECT THE GEOGRAPHIC DIVERSITY OF
- 13 THE COMMONWEALTH.
- 14 (E) VACANCIES. -- THE FOLLOWING SHALL APPLY:
- 15 (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED UNDER PARAGRAPH (2), THE GOVERNOR
- 16 SHALL APPOINT A MEMBER FOR A MEMBERSHIP ON THE TASK FORCE
- 17 THAT REMAINS VACANT FOR 90 DAYS OR MORE.
- 18 (2) THE PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE OF THE SENATE SHALL
- 19 <u>APPOINT A MEMBER FOR A MEMBERSHIP APPOINTED UNDER SUBSECTION</u>
- 20 (C)(5) OR (10) THAT REMAINS VACANT FOR 90 DAYS OR MORE.
- 21 (F) DESIGNEE.--A TASK FORCE MEMBER WHO INTENDS TO UTILIZE A
- 22 DESIGNEE SHALL NOTIFY THE CHAIRPERSON OF THE TASK FORCE IN
- 23 WRITING OF THE DESIGNEE.
- 24 (G) TERMS.--THE TERM OF A TASK FORCE MEMBER APPOINTED UNDER
- 25 SUBSECTION (C)(1), (2), (3), (4), (10), (11) OR (14) SHALL BE
- 26 THREE YEARS. A TASK FORCE MEMBER MAY BE REAPPOINTED FOR
- 27 <u>ADDITIONAL TERMS. AN INDIVIDUAL APPOINTED TO FILL A VACANCY ON</u>
- 28 THE TASK FORCE UNDER SUBSECTION (C) SHALL SERVE FOR THE
- 29 UNEXPIRED TERM OF THE MEMBERSHIP AND SHALL BE ELIGIBLE FOR
- 30 REAPPOINTMENT.

- 1 (H) MEETINGS AND EXPENSES. -- THE FOLLOWING SHALL APPLY: 2 (1) THE TASK FORCE SHALL MEET AT LEAST FOUR TIMES 3 ANNUALLY, BUT MAY HOLD ADDITIONAL MEETINGS AS DETERMINED BY 4 THE CHAIRPERSON. THE CHAIRPERSON SHALL PROVIDE NOTICE OF AT 5 LEAST 14 DAYS IN ADVANCE FOR A REGULAR MEETING AND SHALL 6 PROVIDE NOTICE OF AT LEAST THREE DAYS IN ADVANCE OF A SPECIAL 7 MEETING. 8 (2) A RECORD OF MEETING ATTENDANCE SHALL BE MAINTAINED, 9 AND A MEMBER SHALL RECEIVE WRITTEN NOTICE IF THE MEMBER 10 MISSES TWO CONSECUTIVE MEETINGS. A MEMBER WHO MISSES THREE CONSECUTIVE MEETINGS WITHOUT GOOD CAUSE ACCEPTABLE TO THE 11 CHAIRPERSON MAY BE REPLACED BY A MEMBER APPOINTED BY THE 12 13 GOVERNOR AT THE DISCRETION OF THE CHAIRPERSON. (3) MINUTES OF THE MEETINGS SHALL BE PREPARED AND FILED 14 WITH THE TASK FORCE AND DISTRIBUTED TO EACH MEMBER. EACH 15 RECORD SHALL BE A MATTER OF PUBLIC RECORD. 16 17 (4) A MEMBER MAY NOT RECEIVE PER DIEM EXPENSES. 18 (5) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE APPROPRIATE STAFF SUPPORT TO ENABLE THE TASK FORCE TO PROPERLY CARRY OUT THE 19 20 TASK FORCE'S DUTIES. (I) POWERS. -- THE TASK FORCE SHALL HAVE THE POWER TO ADVISE 21 AND CONSULT THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND COMMONWEALTH AGENCIES AND

- 23 MAY MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (B). IN
- 24 MAKING THOSE RECOMMENDATIONS, THE TASK FORCE SHALL PERFORM THE
- 25 FOLLOWING:
- 26 (1) REVIEW EXISTING LAWS, REGULATIONS AND POLICIES
- 27 WITHIN THE CONTEXT OF CURRENT EMPIRICAL EVIDENCE EVALUATING
- 28 EFFECTIVE CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE.
- 29 (2) REVIEW CURRENT BEST-PRACTICES FOR PRIMARY, SECONDARY
- 30 AND TERTIARY CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE PREVENTION STRATEGIES.

1 (3) GATHER INFORMATION CONCERNING CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE 2 THROUGHOUT THIS COMMONWEALTH. 3 (4) RECEIVE REPORTS AND TESTIMONY FROM INDIVIDUALS, COMMONWEALTH AND LOCAL AGENCIES, COMMUNITY-BASED 4 5 ORGANIZATIONS AND OTHER PUBLIC AND PRIVATE ORGANIZATIONS. 6 (5) DEVELOP GUIDELINES AND TOOLS FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF 7 SEXUAL ABUSE PREVENTION AND INTERVENTION PLANS BY 8 ORGANIZATIONS SERVING CHILDREN AND YOUTH. 9 (6) RECOMMEND POLICIES AND PROCEDURES FOR IMPLEMENTATION 10 AND OVERSIGHT OF THE GUIDELINES. (7) RECOMMEND STRATEGIES FOR INCENTIVIZING ORGANIZATIONS 11 TO DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT SEXUAL ABUSE PREVENTION AND 12 13 INTERVENTION PLANS. - 8 <u>(a) General rule.--</u>The Pennsylvania Commission on
- 9 Sentencing, in accordance with section 2154 (relating to
- 10 adoption of guidelines for sentencing), shall provide for a
- 11 sentence enhancement within its guidelines for an offense under
- 12 18 Pa.C.S. § 6312 (relating to sexual abuse of children),
- 13 specifying variations from the range of sentences applicable
- 14 based on such aggravating circumstances as the age of the child
- 15 or a determination of prepubescence, the number of images
- 16 possessed by the defendant, if the child depicted is known to
- 17 the defendant and the nature and character of the abuse depicted
- 18 in the images.
- 19 (b) Other circumstances. -- When a person commits an offense
- 20 to which the grading provisions under 18 Pa.C.S. § 6312(d.1)(3)
- 21 apply, the Pennsylvania Commission on Sentencing shall, in

- 23 within its guidelines if indecent contact with the child as
- 24 defined in 18 Pa.C.S. § 3101 (relating to definitions) is
