AN ACT

Amending the act of April 23, 1956 (1955 P.L.1510, No.500), entitled "An act providing for the prevention and control of 2 communicable and non-communicable diseases including venereal 3 diseases, fixing responsibility for disease prevention and control, requiring reports of diseases, and authorizing 5 treatment of venereal diseases, and providing for premarital and prenatal blood tests; amending, revising and 7 consolidating the laws relating thereto; and repealing 8 certain acts," further providing for confidentiality of reports and records. 10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 11 12 hereby enacts as follows: 13 Section 1. Section 15 of the act of April 23, 1956 (1955) P.L.1510, No.500), known as the Disease Prevention and Control 14 15 Law of 1955, is amended to read: 16 Section 15. Confidentiality of Reports and Records .--17 (a) <u>Disclosures.--</u>State and local health authorities may not disclose reports of diseases, any records maintained as a result 19 of any action taken in consequence of such reports, or any other 20 records maintained pursuant to this act or any regulations, to any person who is not a member of the department or of a local 21

- 4 (2) The department shall release to the governing body of a
- 5 county and the county emergency management coordinator the
- 6 <u>municipality in which there has been a confirmed case of a</u>
- 7 <u>communicable or reportable disease within the past twenty-four</u>
- 8 hours.
- 9 <u>(b) Research.--</u>State and local health authorities may permit
- 10 the use of data contained in disease reports and other records,
- 11 maintained pursuant to this act, or any regulation, for research
- 12 purposes, subject to strict supervision by the health
- 13 authorities to insure that the use of the reports and records is
- 14 limited to the specific research purposes.
- 15 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
