- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in certification of teachers, FURTHER <--PROVIDING FOR INSTRUCTIONAL CERTIFICATE GRADE SPANS AND AGE LEVELS AND DUTIES OF DEPARTMENT AND providing for special provisions applicable to 2020-2021 school year. 8 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 10 hereby enacts as follows: 11 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known <--12 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a 13 section to read: 14 SECTION 1. SECTION 1202.1(A) OF THE ACT OF MARCH 10, 1949 (P.L.30, NO.14), KNOWN AS THE PUBLIC SCHOOL CODE OF 1949, IS AMENDED BY ADDING A PARAGRAPH TO READ: 16 INSTRUCTIONAL CERTIFICATE GRADE SPANS AND SECTION 1202.1. 17
- 18 AGE LEVELS AND DUTIES OF DEPARTMENT. -- (A) THE FOLLOWING SHALL

- 1 APPLY TO SPECIAL EDUCATION CERTIFICATES:

- 3 (1.1) NOTWITHSTANDING PARAGRAPH (1), A TEACHER PREPARATION
- 4 PROGRAM MAY PERMIT AN INDIVIDUAL ENROLLED AT AN INSTITUTION OF
- 5 HIGHER EDUCATION OR IN AN APPROVED ALTERNATIVE PREPARATION
- 6 PROGRAM PRIOR TO DECEMBER 31 2021, AND WHO REMAINS CONTINUOUSLY
- 7 ENROLLED TO COMPLETE THE PROGRAM FOR THE GRADE LEVEL LIMITATIONS
- 8 PROVIDED UNDER 22 PA. CODE § 49.85(A) AND (B). THE DEPARTMENT
- 9 MAY ISSUE THE APPROPRIATE SPECIAL EDUCATION-PK-8 OR SPECIAL
- 10 EDUCATION-7-12 CERTIFICATES TO AN APPLICANT WHO COMPLETES THE
- 11 PROGRAM AND MEETS ALL OTHER CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS.

- 13 SECTION 2. THE ACT IS AMENDED BY ADDING A SECTION TO READ:
- 14 <u>Section 1207.4. Special Provisions Applicable to 2020-2021</u>
- 15 School Year. -- (a) Beginning on the effective date of this
- 16 <u>subsection and notwithstanding any other provision of law to the</u>
- 17 contrary, the Secretary of Education may do any or all of the
- 18 <u>following:</u>
- 19 (1) Waive the requirement to satisfactorily complete the
- 20 assessment of basic skills required under section 1207.3 and 22
- 21 Pa. Code § 49.18(c) (relating to assessment) during the 2020-
- 22 2021 school year. This paragraph shall expire June 30, 2021.
- 23 (2) Issue a temporary provisional certificate to an educator
- 24 who has completed a preparation program and meets all
- 25 requirements for certification except the satisfactory
- 26 completion of the assessments required pursuant to 22 Pa. Code §
- 27 <u>49.18(c)</u> because the assessments were canceled or could not be
- 28 scheduled. A temporary provisional certificate issued under this
- 29 paragraph shall expire after one year of issuance and may be
- 30 converted to a Level I Pennsylvania certificate upon submission

- 1 of evidence of satisfactory completion of the required
- 2 assessments to the Department of Education. This paragraph shall
- 3 expire on June 30, 2021.
- 4 (3) Issue an exceptional case permit for a professional
- 5 employe at the request of a school entity that employs the
- 6 professional employe who completed the final year of Level I
- 7 Pennsylvania certificate validity in the 2019-2020 school year
- 8 and who was unable to complete the assessment requirements for
- 9 <u>conversion to a Level II Pennsylvania certificate under 22 Pa.</u>
- 10 Code § 49.18(a)(2)(iii) because the assessments were canceled or
- 11 <u>could not be scheduled. The exceptional case permit shall expire</u>
- 12 <u>one year from the date of issuance. This paragraph shall expire</u>
- 13 June 30, 2021.
- 14 (4) Issue a temporary certificate to an individual who is
- 15 unable to complete the appropriate subject matter test for areas
- 16 other than health and physical education, cooperative education,
- 17 all special education areas and additional areas as may be
- 18 determined by the Department of Education under 22 Pa. Code §
- 19 49.18(e) when the Department of Education determines that the
- 20 relevant assessment has been canceled or could not be scheduled.
- 21 An individual who provides evidence as required by the
- 22 Department of Education indicating that the individual attempted
- 23 to access testing and was denied registration may be eligible
- 24 for issuance of a temporary certificate under this paragraph.
- 25 The temporary certificate shall expire one year from the date of
- 26 issuance and may be converted to a full instructional
- 27 certificate by providing proof of satisfactory achievement on
- 28 the required test to the Department of Education. This paragraph
- 29 shall expire June 30, 2021.
- 30 (b) Beginning on the effective date of this subsection and

- 1 <u>notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the</u>
- 2 <u>deadline by which any paraprofessional employed by a school</u>
- 3 entity as of March 13, 2020, must satisfy staff development
- 4 <u>activity hour requirements under 22 Pa. Code § 14.105 (relating</u>
- 5 to personnel) shall be extended until June 30, 2021. This
- 6 <u>subsection shall expire one year from the effective date of this</u>
- 7 subsection.
- 8 Section 2 3. This act shall take effect immediately. AS <--
- 9 FOLLOWS:
- 10 (1) THE AMENDMENT OF SECTION 1202.1(A) SHALL TAKE EFFECT
- 11 IN 60 DAYS.
- 12 (2) THE REMAINDER OF THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT
