A SUPPLEMENT

1 To the act of June 28, 2019 (P.L.839, No.1A), entitled "An act
2 to provide appropriations from the General Fund for the
3 expenses of the Executive, Legislative and Judicial
4 Departments of the Commonwealth, the public debt and the
5 public schools for the fiscal year July 1, 2019, to June 30,
6 2020, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining
7 unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019;
8 to provide appropriations from special funds and accounts to
9 the Executive and Judicial Departments for the fiscal year
10 July 1, 2019, to June 30, 2020, and for the payment of bills
11 remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June
12 30, 2019; to provide for the appropriation of Federal funds
13 to the Executive and Judicial Departments for the fiscal year
14 July 1, 2019, to June 30, 2020, and for the payment of bills
15 remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June
16 30, 2019; and to provide for the additional appropriation of
17 Federal and State funds to the Executive and Judicial
18 Departments for the fiscal year July 1, 2018, to June 30,
19 2019, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining
20 unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018,"
21 adding Federal appropriations to the Executive Department of
22 the Commonwealth for the fiscal year July 1, 2019, to June
23 30, 2020.

24 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
25 hereby enacts as follows:

26 PART I

27 GENERAL PROVISIONS

28 Section 101. Short title.

1 This act shall be known and may be cited as the 2020 Pandemic
2 Emergency Supplement to the General Appropriation Act of 2019.
3 Section 102. Definitions.

4 The definitions in the act of June 28, 2019 (P.L.839, No.1A),
5 known as the General Appropriation Act of 2019, shall apply to
6 this act.

7 Section 103. Abbreviations.

8 The abbreviations in the act of June 28, 2019 (P.L.839,
9 No.1A), known as the General Appropriation Act of 2019, shall
10 apply to this act.

11 Section 104. Federal appropriations.

12 The sums specified in this act, or as much thereof as may be
13 necessary, are specifically appropriated from the special funds
14 and accounts in the State Treasury to agencies of the Executive
15 Department of the Commonwealth for the payment of salaries,
16 wages or other compensation and travel expenses of the duly
17 appointed officers and employees of the Commonwealth, for the
18 payment of fees for contractual services rendered, for the
19 purchase or rental of goods and services and for payment of any
20 other expenses, as provided by law or by this act, necessary for
21 the proper conduct of the duties, functions and activities and
22 for the purposes specified in this act for the current fiscal
23 year and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid
24 at the close of the prior fiscal year.

4 Section 301. Continuing appropriations.

5 The appropriations in this act shall be continuing
6 appropriations and shall not automatically lapse as of the close
7 of the current fiscal year.

8 Section 302. Applicability.

9 (a) General rule.--The provisions of the act of June 28,
10 2019 (P.L.839, No.1A), known as the General Appropriation Act of
11 2019, shall apply to this act.

12 (b) Retroactivity.--This act shall be retroactive to July 1,
13 2019.

14 Section 303. Effective date.

15 This act shall take effect immediately.
