AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, in employees, providing for medals
- 3 honoring law enforcement officers.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Chapter 21 of Title 53 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subchapter to read:
- 8 <u>SUBCHAPTER F</u>
- 9 MEDALS HONORING LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS

- 13 2193. Form of medals.
- 14 § 2191. Establishment of program.
- 15 A program is established for the Governor to recognize and
- 16 <u>decorate law enforcement officers in this Commonwealth who have</u>
- 17 <u>demonstrated bravery</u>, <u>sacrifice or other exceptionally</u>

- 1 meritorious conduct in the line of duty. The Municipal Police
- 2 Officers' Education and Training Commission established in
- 3 <u>Subchapter D (relating to municipal police education and</u>
- 4 training) shall assist the Governor in the administration of the
- 5 program by establishing the qualifications, protocol and other
- 6 <u>rules necessary to carry out the purposes of this subchapter.</u>
- 7 <u>§ 2192. Medal procedure.</u>
- 8 <u>(a) Nominees.--A member of the Pennsylvania State Police or</u>
- 9 <u>a police officer of a police department as defined in section</u>
- 10 2162 (relating to definitions) may be nominated for a medal
- 11 <u>under this subchapter.</u>
- 12 (b) Application. -- An application that nominates a law
- 13 <u>enforcement officer for a medal may be submitted to the</u>
- 14 Municipal Police Officers' Education and Training Commission by
- 15 the Governor, a member of the General Assembly, the Commissioner
- 16 of Pennsylvania State Police, a county sheriff or the chief
- 17 executive of a municipality or police department.
- 18 (c) Review and issuance of medals. -- The Municipal Police
- 19 Officers' Education and Training Commission shall review an
- 20 application's veracity and conformance to the criteria of the
- 21 program and notify the Governor of the applications that are in
- 22 compliance. The final decision to issue a medal under this
- 23 subchapter shall rest with the Governor. The Governor may
- 24 delegate to the Lieutenant Governor or a member of the General
- 25 Assembly the act of presenting a medal.
- 26 § 2193. Form of medals.
- 27 <u>(a) General rule.--The medals authorized under the program</u>
- 28 shall be in the following forms:
- 29 (1) Blue Star of Valor, which may be awarded to law
- 30 enforcement officers who have shown exceptional gallantry,

- heroism and bravery in the face of life-threatening
- 2 <u>circumstances above and beyond the call of duty.</u>
- 3 (2) Blue Heart, which may be issued to law enforcement
- 4 <u>officers injured in the line of duty.</u>
- 5 (3) Medal of Ultimate Sacrifice, which shall be issued
- 6 <u>posthumously to law enforcement officers who have fallen in</u>
- 7 <u>the line of duty.</u>
- 8 (b) Design. -- The design of each medal shall be approved by
- 9 <u>the Municipal Police Officers' Education and Training</u>
- 10 Commission. Each medal shall be cast in bronze or other metal
- 11 and the design shall incorporate the seal of the Commonwealth.
- 12 (c) Cost.--The cost of a medal shall be paid by the
- 13 Pennsylvania State Police or the police department by which the
- 14 law enforcement officer is or was employed. The family of a
- 15 medal recipient may request a second medal and may receive the
- 16 medal upon payment to the Municipal Police Officers' Education
- 17 and Training Commission of the cost of the medal.
- 18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
