## A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 2 3	Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in taxation and finance, providing for expiration of authority to levy or collect real property tax.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby resolves as follows:
6	Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
7	Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
8	(1) That Article VIII be amended by adding a section to
9	read:
10	<u>§ 18. Expiration of authority to levy or collect real property</u>
11	taxes.
12	(a) No school district may levy a tax on real property after
13	June 30, 2023. This subsection shall not prohibit a school
14	district from collecting a tax levied prior to June 30, 2023.
15	(b) The Legislature shall, by general law, provide annually
16	each school district with maintenance and support in an amount
17	at least equal to the real property tax collected by the school
18	district on real property during the fiscal year ending June 30,

1	2023, less the annual debt service legally obligated to be paid
2	by the school district during the fiscal year ending June 30,
3	2023. The maintenance and support of school districts may
4	include, but need not be limited to:
5	(1) A State tax on each separate sale at retail of tangible
6	personal property or services in this Commonwealth.
7	(2) A State tax on the receipt of income by every resident
8	individual, estate or trust.
9	(3) A local tax on the receipt of income by every resident
10	<u>individual, estate or trust.</u>
11	(4) A local tax on earned income and net profits.
12	(c) Under no circumstances may the General Assembly provide,
13	by general, local or special law, for a tax on real property.
14	(d) Except for taxes imposed under subsection (b)(3) and
15	(4), all proceeds from other taxes imposed under subsection (b),
16	shall be deposited in a separate fund in the State Treasury, to
17	be known as the Stabilization of Education Fund, and shall be
18	used for the purpose of the maintenance and support of school
19	districts required under subsection (a). The money in the fund
20	may not be diverted by transfer or otherwise to any other
21	purpose.
22	Section 2. (a) Upon the first passage by the General
23	Assembly of this proposed constitutional amendment, the
24	Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to

25 comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article 26 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the 27 required advertisements to two newspapers in every county in 28 which such newspapers are published in sufficient time after 29 passage of this proposed constitutional amendment.

30 (b) Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of this

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1 proposed constitutional amendment, the Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the 2 advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the 3 Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the required 4 advertisements to two newspapers in every county in which such 5 6 newspapers are published in sufficient time after passage of this proposed constitutional amendment. The Secretary of the 7 Commonwealth shall submit this proposed constitutional amendment 8 to the qualified electors of this Commonwealth at the first 9 primary, general or municipal election which meets the 10 11 requirements of and is in conformance with section 1 of Article 12 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and which occurs at least three months after the proposed constitutional amendment is 13 passed by the General Assembly. 14
