AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 66 (Public Utilities) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, in service and facilities, providing
- for pipeline emergency management information.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Chapter 15 of Title 66 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subchapter to read:
- 8 SUBCHAPTER C
- 9 <u>PIPELINE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT INFORMATION</u>

- 11 <u>1541. Definitions.</u>
- 12 1542. Pipeline emergency management information.
- 13 <u>1543. Penalties.</u>
- 14 § 1541. Definitions.
- 15 The following words and phrases when used in this subchapter
- 16 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 17 <u>context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 18 "Gas." As defined in 49 CFR 192.3 (relating to definitions).

- 1 <u>"Gas high consequence area." A "high consequence area" as</u>
- 2 defined in 49 CFR 192.903 (relating to what definitions apply to
- 3 this subpart?).
- 4 "Hazardous liquid." As defined in 49 CFR 195.2 (relating to
- 5 definitions).
- 6 <u>"Hazardous liquid high consequence area." Any of the</u>
- 7 <u>following:</u>
- 8 (1) A commercially navigable waterway where a
- 9 <u>substantial likelihood of commercial navigation exists.</u>
- 10 (2) A high-population area or urbanized area, defined
- and delineated by the United States Census Bureau, that
- 12 <u>contains 50,000 or more people and has a population density</u>
- of at least 1,000 people per square mile.
- 14 (3) Another populated area, defined and delineated by
- the United States Census Bureau, as containing a concentrated
- 16 <u>population, including, but not limited to, an incorporated or</u>
- 17 unincorporated city, town, village or other designated
- 18 residential or commercial area.
- 19 (4) An unusually sensitive area as defined in 49 CFR
- 20 195.6 (relating to Unusually Sensitive Areas (USAs)),
- 21 including a Class 1b aguifer, a lithology of which includes
- 22 limestone, dolomite and locally evaporitic units that contain
- documented karst features or solution channels, regardless of
- 24 size.
- 25 "Potential impact radius." The radius of a circle within
- 26 which the potential failure of a pipeline could have significant
- 27 <u>impact on people or property.</u>
- 28 "Transmission." The transportation, other than gathering, of
- 29 gas through a transmission line as that term is defined in 49
- 30 CFR 192.3 or of hazardous liquids through a pipeline as that

- 1 term is defined in 49 CFR 195.2.
- 2 § 1542. Pipeline emergency management information.
- 3 (a) Local organization notice. -- At least twice each calendar
- 4 year, a public utility operating facilities for the transmission
- 5 of gas or hazardous liquids shall meet with each local emergency
- 6 management organization in the area in which the facilities are
- 7 <u>located. The public utility shall provide to each local</u>
- 8 <u>emergency management organization the following information at a</u>
- 9 minimum:
- 10 (1) Identification of any gas high consequence area or
- 11 <u>hazardous liquid high consequence area and potential impact</u>
- 12 <u>radius located within the jurisdictional limits of the local</u>
- 13 <u>emergency management organization.</u>
- 14 (2) The public utility's current emergency operating
- procedures.
- 16 (b) Local coordinator responsibilities. -- The local emergency
- 17 management organization coordinator shall consider the
- 18 <u>information received under subsection (a)</u>, as appropriate, when
- 19 planning, administering and operating the local organization
- 20 <u>under 35 Pa.C.S. Ch. 75 (relating to local organizations and</u>
- 21 services).
- 22 § 1543. Penalties.
- 23 The commission may, after notice and opportunity to be heard,
- 24 <u>impose civil penalties under section 3301 (relating to civil</u>
- 25 penalties for violations) and other appropriate remedies for
- 26 violations of this subchapter and the regulations and orders of
- 27 the commission.
- 28 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
