18	"Gas." As defined in 49 CFR 192.3 (relating to definitions).
19	"Hazardous liquid." As defined in 49 CFR 195.2 (relating to

"Transmission." The transportation, other than gathering, of 3 gas through a transmission line as that term is defined in 49 4 CFR 192.3 or of hazardous liquids through a pipeline as that 5 term is defined in 49 CFR 195.2. 6 * * * 7 8 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read: 9 Section 4.1. Pipeline operation and emergency response plans. 10 (a) General rule. -- A public utility operating facilities for the transmission of gas or hazardous liquids which provides an 11 12 operation and emergency response plan containing confidential

13 security information to the Pennsylvania Public Utility

14 Commission under section 4 shall maintain a complete, accurate

15 and up-to-date version of the operation and emergency response

16 plan on file with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission.

17 (b) Definition.--As used in this section, the term

18 <u>"operation and emergency response plan" means the information</u>

19 required under 49 CFR 195.402 (relating to procedural manual for

20 operations, maintenance, and emergencies) and an emergency plan

21 as provided under 49 CFR 192.615 (relating to emergency plans).

26 (b) Exception.--Notwithstanding subsection (a), [an] <u>the</u> 27 following shall apply:

<u>(1) An</u> agency may, after notification and consultation
with the public utility, disclose a public utility record or
portion thereof which contains confidential security

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1 information, in accordance with the provisions of this act, 2 that is necessary for construction, renovation or remodeling 3 work on any public building or project. Release or disclosure of such records or portions thereof for these purposes does 4 5 not constitute prohibited disclosure under subsection (a) and 6 does not result in such records or portions thereof becoming 7 public records subject to the provisions of the act of June 8 21, 1957 (P.L.390, No.212), referred to as the Right-to-Know 9 Law.

10 (2) The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission may, after notification and consultation with a public utility 11 12 operating facilities for the transmission of gas or hazardous 13 liquids, disclose an operation and emergency response plan or 14 portion thereof which contains confidential security information, in accordance with the provisions of this act, 15 16 that is necessary for a county emergency management agency 17 director to fulfill their obligations under 35 Pa.C.S. 18 (relating to health and safety). 19 (3) The disclosure permitted under paragraph (2) shall 20 be made only after the county emergency management agency 21 director, with authority to bind the county emergency 22 management agency, agrees to and signs a nondisclosure 23 agreement which, in the judgment of the Pennsylvania Public 24 Utility Commission, contains adequate protections against the 25 unauthorized or inadvertent disclosure of confidential 26 security information. (c) Definition. -- As used in this section, the term 27 "operation and emergency response plan" means the information 28 29 required under 49 CFR 195.402 (relating to procedural manual for operations, maintenance, and emergencies) and an emergency plan 30

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- 1 as provided under 49 CFR 192.615 (relating to emergency plans).
- 2 Section 4. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
