## INTRODUCED BY CORMAN, MAY 3, 2019

AN ACT

Authorizing the Department of General Services, with the approval of the Governor, to grant and convey to the County of Mifflin certain lands of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania at the State Fire Academy situate in the Borough of Lewistown, Mifflin County, together with appurtenant parking, for the benefit of the general public.
The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. Conveyance in the Borough of Lewistown, Mifflin County.
(a) Authorization.--The Department of General Services, with the approval of the Governor and the State Fire Commissioner, is hereby authorized on behalf of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to grant and convey to Mifflin County a permanent easement from lands of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania at the State Fire Academy situate in the Borough of Lewistown, Mifflin County, for the purpose of establishing and maintaining a recreational hiking trail, together with appurtenant parking for the benefit of the general public for $\$ 1$ and under terms and conditions to be established in an easement agreement.
(b) Property description.--The permanent easement to be conveyed pursuant to section 1 consists of an area of approximately 1.02 -acres, bounded and more particularly described as follows:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate in the Borough of Lewistown, County of Mifflin, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, depicted on a plan prepared by The EADS Group, dated March 2019, as last revised, and being more fully described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point along Riverside Drive, THENCE North $57^{\circ} 22^{\prime \prime} 17^{\prime \prime}$ East, 247.79 feet to a point of non-tangency;

THENCE South $85^{\circ} 11^{\prime 2} 29^{\prime \prime}$ East, 166.94 feet to the beginning of a curve concave southerly, said curve has a radius of 65.00 feet;

THENCE easterly along said curve through a central angle of 25³6'54" an arc distance of 29.06 feet to a point of tangency;

THENCE South 59³4'35" East, 81.41 feet to the beginning of a non-tangent curve concave southwesterly, said curve has a radius of 42.38 feet, to which a radial line bears North $30^{\circ} 45^{\prime \prime} 54^{\prime \prime}$ East;

THENCE southeasterly along said curve through a central angle of $71^{\circ} 20^{\prime} 3^{\prime \prime}$ an arc distance of 52.77 feet to a point of nontangency;

THENCE South $7^{\circ} 38^{\prime} 3^{\prime \prime}$ West, 28.79 feet to a point of nontangency;

THENCE North $65^{\circ} 11^{\prime} 11^{\prime \prime}$ East, 72.23 feet to a point of nontangency; to a shared boundary with now or formerly Mifflin Concrete, Inc, THENCE along that boundary South 46²0'50" East, 32.25 feet to a point of non-tangency;

THENCE South $65^{\circ} 11^{\prime} 11^{\prime \prime}$ West, 96.68 feet to the beginning of a
curve concave southeasterly, said curve has a radius of 85.00 feet;

THENCE southwesterly along said curve through a central angle of $25^{\circ} 30^{\prime} 52^{\prime \prime}$ an arc distance of 37.85 feet to a point of tangency;

THENCE South $39^{\circ} 40^{\prime} 19{ }^{\prime \prime}$ West, 344.42 feet to the beginning of a curve concave southeasterly, said curve has a radius of 85.00 feet;

THENCE southwesterly along said curve through a central angle of $14^{\circ} 14^{\prime} 23^{\prime \prime}$ an arc distance of 21.13 feet to a point of tangency;

THENCE South $25^{\circ} 25^{\prime} 5^{\prime \prime}$ West, 442.21 feet to a point of nontangency; to a shared boundary with now or formerly Lowes Home Center, Inc;

THENCE along that boundary, North $77^{\circ} 36^{\prime 2} 20^{\prime \prime}$ West, 30.79 feet to a point of non-tangency;

THENCE North $25^{\circ} 25^{\prime} 5^{\prime \prime}$ East, 449.15 feet to the beginning of a curve concave southeasterly, said curve has a radius of 115.00 feet;

THENCE northeasterly along said curve through a central angle of $14^{\circ} 14^{\prime} 23^{\prime \prime}$ an arc distance of 28.58 feet to a point of tangency;

THENCE North $39^{\circ} 40^{\prime} 19{ }^{\prime \prime}$ East, 344.42 feet to the beginning of a curve concave southeasterly, said curve has a radius of 115.00 feet;

THENCE northeasterly along said curve through a central angle of $10^{\circ} 19^{\prime} 14^{\prime \prime}$ an arc distance of 20.71 feet to a point of reverse curvature, said curve is concave northwesterly and has a radius of 15.00 feet;

THENCE northeasterly along said curve through a central angle
of $42^{\circ} 20^{\prime} 58^{\prime \prime}$ an arc distance of 11.09 feet to a point of tangency;

THENCE North $7^{\circ} 38^{\prime} 3^{\prime \prime}$ East, 46.54 feet to the beginning of a non-tangent curve concave westerly and has a radius of 12.38 feet, to which a radial line bears South 7405'35" East;

THENCE northerly along said curve through a central angle of 7451'05" an arc distance of 16.18 feet to a point of nontangency;

THENCE North 59³4'35" West, 81.29 feet to the beginning of a curve concave southerly and has a radius of 35.00 feet;

THENCE westerly along said curve through a central angle of 25³6'54" an arc distance of 15.65 feet to a point of tangency;

THENCE North $85^{\circ} 11^{\prime} 29^{\prime \prime}$ West, 192.42 feet to a point of nontangency;

THENCE South $32^{\circ} 21^{\prime \prime} 43^{\prime \prime}$ East, 21.67 feet to a point of nontangency;

THENCE South $57^{\circ} 22^{\prime} 19^{\prime \prime}$ West, 119.98 feet to a point of nontangency;

THENCE North $32^{\circ} 25^{\prime} 08^{\prime \prime}$ West, 14.73 feet to a point of nontangency;

THENCE South $57^{\circ} 34^{\prime} 52^{\prime \prime}$ West, 89.30 to a point of nontangency;

THENCE North $32^{\circ} 37^{\prime} 41^{\prime \prime}$ West, 14.95 feet to the point of beginning.

CONTAINING 1.02-acres.
The permanent easement is located entirely within the lands known as the State Fire Academy, acquired by an Indenture dated November 13, 1986 from the General State Authority to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, acting by and through the Department of General Services, and recorded at the Office of
the Recorder of Deeds of Mifflin County at Deed Book 318, Page 998.
(c) Agreement.--The easement agreement, and any other documents necessary to effectuate the above described conveyance, shall be executed by the Secretary of General Services in the name of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
(d) Restriction.--The easement agreement shall contain a condition that the easement shall be utilized by the grantee, its successors or assigns, solely for the purposes of establishing and maintaining a recreational trail, together with appurtenant parking, for the benefit of the general public and for no other purpose. Should the easement not be utilized for the purposes set forth in this section, the easement shall automatically extinguish.
(e) Costs and fees.--Costs and fees incidental to the conveyance described herein shall be borne by the grantee.
(f) Expiration.--If the parties have not entered into an easement agreement within two years of the effective date of this act, the authorization contained herein shall expire. Section 2. Effective date.

This act shall take effect immediately.
