- 4 distinction as the oldest Greek-lettered organization
- 5 established by African-American college-educated women; and
- 6 WHEREAS, With more than 1,000 undergraduate and graduate
- 7 chapters and 300,000 members throughout the United States, the
- 8 United States Virgin Islands, the Caribbean, Canada, Japan,
- 9 Germany, South Korea, Africa and other nations, AKA has grown
- 10 and flourished in the pursuit of peace and improved quality of
- 11 life for others since its establishment in 1908 at Howard
- 12 University in Washington, DC, by founder Ethel Hedgeman Lyle;

- 14 WHEREAS, AKA members have generously engaged their energies
- 15 in global advocacy and service projects to improve
- 16 socioeconomic, racial, political and environmental conditions as
- 17 AKA's functions have expanded for more than a century; and

- 2 the membership of AKA have earned recognition for their
- 3 excellent academic records, proven leadership skills,
- 4 impassioned volunteerism and effective outreach; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Annually, the International Program regularly
- 6 schedules six Community Impact Days to highlight AKA's
- 7 collective impact in the five target areas of education, women's
- 8 health care and wellness, building economic legacy, the arts and

- 10 WHEREAS, The Senate proudly notes the strength of AKA's
- 11 relationships with the residents and elected officials of this
- 12 Commonwealth; and
