A RESOLUTION

Urging the Congress of the United States to ensure the United 1 States Department of Veterans Affairs sufficiently implements 2 the letter and spirit of the VA Maintaining Internal Systems 3 and Strengthening Integrated Outside Networks (MISSION) Act 5 of 2018 and provide veterans in this Commonwealth with the care they have earned for their military service. 6 7 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth has a population of approximately 800,000 veterans; and 8 9 WHEREAS, The health and well-being of this Commonwealth's veterans is of the utmost concern of the Senate of the 10 11 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and 12 WHEREAS, On June 6, 2018, the bipartisan VA MISSION Act of 1.3 2018 (Public Law 115-182, 132 Stat. 1393) was signed into law 14 and supported by more than 30 veteran and military service 15 organizations; and 16 WHEREAS, The successful implementation of the VA MISSION Act 17 of 2018 includes all of the following requirements: 18 Consolidating the United States Department of (1)19 Veterans Affairs (VA) seven community care programs into a

- 1 new Veterans Community Care Program and creating clear
- 2 eligibility standards for a veteran to access community care
- 3 if the VA does not offer the health care or services the
- 4 veteran needs.
- 5 (2) Creating seamless access to local urgent care
- 6 facilities.
- 7 (3) Innovating health care delivery and increasing
- 8 timely claims processing systems to reimburse community
- 9 providers.
- 10 (4) Strengthening the VA's workforce by allowing the VA
- 11 to recruit and retain the best medical providers.
- 12 (5) Removing barriers for VA healthcare professionals to
- 13 practice telemedicine.
- 14 (6) Expanding eligibility for the VA Family Caregiver
- Program to veterans from all eras of service who were
- seriously injured while serving in the military, rather than
- only those veterans who have served since September 11, 2001.
- 18 (7) Allowing the VA to partner with the six veterans'
- homes operated by the Commonwealth by entering into provider
- 20 agreements that are not subject to Federal contracting
- 21 regulations.
- 22 (8) Strengthening the VA's ability to manage its real
- 23 property portfolio and build a high-performing, integrated
- 24 health care system;

- 26 WHEREAS, Our nation's veterans have made enormous sacrifices
- 27 to guarantee our freedoms; and
- 28 WHEREAS, Although our nation can never fully repay its debt
- 29 of gratitude to our veterans, it can and should ensure timely
- 30 access to the highest quality of healthcare for our veterans;

- 2 RESOLVED, That the Senate of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 3 urge the Congress of the United States to ensure the United
- 4 States Department of Veterans Affairs sufficiently implements
- 5 the letter and spirit of the VA Maintaining Internal Systems and
- 6 Strengthening Integrated Outside Networks (MISSION) Act of 2018
- 7 and provide veterans in this Commonwealth with the care they
- 8 have earned for their military service; and be it further
- 9 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to
- 10 the President of the United States and to each member of
- 11 Congress from Pennsylvania.
