A RESOLUTION

1 Commemorating the 75th anniversary of D-Day on June 6, 2019.

2 WHEREAS, On June 6, 1944, more than 160,000 Allied troops  
3 landed along a 50-mile stretch of heavily fortified French  
4 coastline to fight Nazi Germany on the beaches of Normandy,  
5 France; and

6 WHEREAS, Allied Commander Dwight D. Eisenhower called the  
7 operation a crusade in which "we will accept nothing less than  
8 full victory"; and

9 WHEREAS, More than 5,000 ships and 13,000 aircraft supported  
10 the D-Day invasion, and by day's end on June 6, the Allies had  
11 taken a foothold in Normandy; and

12 WHEREAS, The D-Day cost was high, with more than 9,000 Allied  
13 soldiers killed or wounded, but more than 100,000 soldiers began  
14 the march across Europe to defeat Hitler; and

15 WHEREAS, The massive military action on June 6 marked the  
16 beginning of the end of Hitler's atrocities throughout Europe

1 and is a historic day; therefore be it

2 RESOLVED, That the Senate commemorate the 75th anniversary of

3 D-Day on June 6, 2019.
