A RESOLUTION

1 Designating the week of October 21 through 27, 2019, as
2 "Business Women's Week" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania was founded on the tenets of fairness,
4 inclusion and tolerance, and we must continue to pursue these
5 ideals in an ever-changing global economy; and

6 WHEREAS, Women in Pennsylvania are an integral part of our
7 economic engine and have worked diligently in pursuit of equal

9 WHEREAS, Women in Pennsylvania develop and lead successful
10 businesses, are highly educated and are trained professionals
11 who distinguish themselves as leaders in specialized and
12 challenging fields; and

13 WHEREAS, Women in the workplace and their allies advocate for
14 programs and policies that will benefit all members of society,
15 including equal pay for equal work, paid sick leave, paid family
16 leave and equal leadership and advancement opportunities; and

17 WHEREAS, Our economy is strongest when we level the playing

4 WHEREAS, Working women, allies and advocacy groups throughout
