A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the week of February 2 through 8, 2020, as "National
2 Future Business Leaders of America-Phi Beta Lambda Week" in
3 Pennsylvania.

4 WHEREAS, Future Business Leaders of America-Phi Beta Lambda
5 (FBLA-PBL) is a nonprofit educational organization whose first
6 chapter was established in Johnson City, Tennessee, in 1942; and

7 WHEREAS, The first Pennsylvania chapter was chartered in
8 1943; and

9 WHEREAS, More than 301 active chapters operated in this
10 Commonwealth during the 2018-2019 school year, inspiring and
11 preparing students for community-minded leadership roles in a
12 global society; and

13 WHEREAS, Students in middle schools, high schools, colleges,
14 universities, career and technical schools and private business
15 schools pursue relevant career preparation, scholarship
16 opportunities, leadership experiences, school-to-work
17 activities, community service events and partnerships with local
18 professionals; and

1 WHEREAS, In advancing career education while building
2 personal and professional skills, FBLA focuses on principles of
3 business and leadership and PBL focuses on transitions from
4 school to work; therefore be it
