A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 Terminating the disaster emergency declared in response to the
2 cases of COVID-19 in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, 35 Pa.C.S. § 7301(c) (relating to general authority
4 of governor) authorizes the Governor to declare a state of
5 disaster emergency; and

6 WHEREAS, On March 6, 2020, the Governor issued a proclamation
7 declaring a disaster emergency in response to the existence of
8 COVID-19 cases in Pennsylvania; and

9 WHEREAS, 35 Pa.C.S. § 7301(c) authorizes the General Assembly
10 by concurrent resolution to terminate a state of disaster
11 emergency at any time; therefore be it

12 RESOLVED, (the House of Representatives concurring) That the
13 General Assembly terminate the disaster emergency declared in
14 response to the existence of COVID-19 cases in Pennsylvania and
15 direct the Governor to issue an executive order or proclamation
16 terminating the disaster emergency as required under 35 Pa.C.S.
17 § 7301(c).
