## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Raising awareness of the dangers of smoking and vaping during 2 the COVID-19 pandemic.
- 3 WHEREAS, According to the Center for Tobacco Control Research
- 4 and Education, smoking is associated with more than doubling the
- 5 odds of disease progression in people who had already developed
- 6 COVID-19; and
- WHEREAS, According to the World Health Organization, smokers
- 8 are more likely to develop severe disease with COVID-19 compared
- 9 with nonsmokers; and
- 10 WHEREAS, According to the National Institute on Drug Abuse,
- 11 COVID-19 is an especially serious threat to those who smoke
- 12 tobacco or who vape because the disease attacks the lungs; and
- 13 WHEREAS, The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, the
- 14 Food and Drug Administration, the Surgeon General and State
- 15 health departments advocate that stopping smoking and vaping and
- 16 avoiding secondhand exposure should be added to the list of
- 17 important preventative measures for COVID-19; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Smokers should discuss with their doctors options to

- 1 quit smoking or vaping, including nicotine patches, gum or
- 2 smoking cessation medications, with expert coaching and support,
- 3 including calling 1-800-QUIT-NOW; therefore be it
- 4 RESOLVED, That the Senate raise awareness of the dangers of
- 5 smoking and vaping during the COVID-19 pandemic; and be it
- 6 further
- 7 RESOLVED, That the Senate encourage individuals who smoke or
- 8 vape to make every effort to quit during the COVID-19 pandemic
- 9 because of the serious potential risks associated with smoking
- 10 or vaping and COVID-19.
