INTRODUCED BY DiSANTO, CORMAN, MASTRIANO AND MARTIN, SEPTEMBER 17, 2020

SENATOR DiSANTO, STATE GOVERNMENT, AS AMENDED, SEPTEMBER 22, 2020

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 Calling for an amendment to the Constitution of the United
2 States via a Convention of the States, pursuant to Article V
3 of the Constitution of the United States, establishing term
4 limits for members of Congress.

5 WHEREAS, The General Assembly, hereby makes an application to
6 Congress as provided by Article V of the Constitution of the
7 ~~Unites~~ UNITED States to call a convention limited to proposing <--
8 an amendment to the Constitution of the United States to set a
9 limit on the number of terms that a person may be elected as a
10 member of the United States Senate and to set a limit on the
11 number of terms that a person may be elected as A member of the <--
12 United States House of Representatives; and

13 WHEREAS, This application shall be considered as covering the
14 same subject matter as the applications from other states to
15 Congress to call a convention to set a limit on the number of
16 terms that a person may be elected to the United States Senate
17 and the United States House of Representatives; and

18 WHEREAS, This application shall be aggregated with same for

1 the purpose of attaining the two-thirds of states necessary to
2 require Congress to call a limited convention on this subject,
3 but shall not be aggregated with any other applications on any
4 other subject; and

5 WHEREAS, This application shall constitute a continuing
6 application in accordance with Article V of the Constitution of
7 the United States until the legislatures of at least two-thirds
8 of the several states have made applications on the same
9 subject; therefore be it

10 RESOLVED (the House of Representatives concurring), That the
11 General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in
12 accordance with Article V of the Constitution of the United
13 States, call for an amendment to set a limit on the number of
14 terms that a person may be elected as a member of the United
15 States Senate and to set a limit on the number of terms that a
16 person may be elected as a member of the United States House of
17 Representatives; and be it further

18 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to
19 the President of the United States Senate, Secretary of the
20 United States Senate, Speaker of the United States House of
21 Representatives, Clerk of the United States House of
22 Representatives and Chairman of the Judiciary Committee of the
23 United States House of Representatives, each member of Congress
24 from Pennsylvania and the other 49 State legislatures,
25 requesting their cooperation.
