## A RESOLUTION

- Adopting a temporary rule of the Senate relating to bills and amendments to be considered in session for the period November 1 through November 30, 2020.
- 4 RESOLVED, That the Senate adopt a temporary rule to read:
- 5 TEMPORARY RULE
- 6 I. Bills and Amendments During Sine Die
- 7 1. During any session of the Senate from November 1 through
- 8 November 30, 2020, the Senate shall only consider the full
- 9 subject matter of appropriations bills, budget implementation
- 10 bills and amendments thereto as qualified by the Temporary
- 11 Budget Rule of 2019-2020 (Senate Resolution 400). For the
- 12 purposes of this rule, budget implementation bills include, but
- 13 are not limited to, bills that include provisions necessary to
- 14 implement a General Appropriation Bill and any bill that amends
- 15 the following:
- 16 a. The act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The
- 17 Administrative Code of 1929;
- 18 b. The act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), known as The

- 1 Fiscal Code;
- 2 c. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the
- 3 Public School Code of 1949;
- d. The act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the
- 5 Human Services Code; and
- e. The act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), known as the Tax
- 7 Reform Code of 1971.
- 8 f. Any bill that will generate at least \$50 million in
- 9 revenue for deposit in the General Fund on a recurring annual
- 10 basis.
- 11 II. Suspension
- 12 This temporary rule may be temporarily suspended only by a
- 13 two-thirds vote of the members elected to the Senate.
- 14 III. Nonapplicability
- Rule 25 of the Rules of the Senate, insofar as it applies to
- 16 a temporary suspension of the Rules of the Senate, shall not
- 17 apply to this temporary rule.
