## AN ACT

Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), entitled "An act concerning elections, including general, municipal, 2 special and primary elections, the nomination of candidates, 3 primary and election expenses and election contests; creating and defining membership of county boards of elections; 5 imposing duties upon the Secretary of the Commonwealth, courts, county boards of elections, county commissioners; imposing penalties for violation of the act, and codifying, 6 7 8 revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto; and 9 repealing certain acts and parts of acts relating to 10 elections," in preparation for and conduct of primaries and 11 elections, providing for <del>cargo</del> BALLOT securement. 12 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 14 15 Section 1. The act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), known 16 as the Pennsylvania Election Code, is amended by adding a 17 section to read: 18 Section 1234. Cargo BALLOT Securement. -- (a) Each county 19 board shall use a cargo securement procedure ADOPT BALLOT 20 SECURITY PROCEDURES, in accordance with this section, to ensure that ballots cast in an election are not tampered with or 21 22 counted erroneously.

- 1 (b) Ballots cast in an election shall be secured in a
- 2 <u>transportation container with DURING ANY POINT IN WHICH THE</u> <--
- 3 BALLOTS ARE NOT AT A VOTING PRECINCT OR COUNTY BOARD OF
- 4 ELECTIONS, UNLESS IN CUSTODY OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL
- 5 SERVICE. THE TRANSPORTATION CONTAINER SHALL POSSESS a numbered
- 6 security tag that seals the transportation container and
- 7 <u>includes an individually identifiable number.</u>
- 8 (c) The following apply to a bill of lading FOR BALLOTS <--
- 9 OUTSIDE OF A VOTING PRECINCT OR COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS:
- 10 (1) The cargo securement procedures BALLOT SECURITY <--
- 11 PROCEDURE under this section shall include a bill of lading
- 12 <u>sealed within each transportation container described in</u>
- 13 <u>subsection</u> (b), which shall accompany the ballots cast in the
- 14 <u>election:</u>
- (i) at the location that the ballots are initially
- 16 collected;
- 17 (ii) while the ballots are in transit; and
- 18 (iii) at any storage location for the ballots UNTIL THE <-
- 19 BALLOTS ARE PRECANVASSED OR CANVASSED.
- 20 (2) The bill of lading shall include the location, date and
- 21 time that the ballots cast in the election were collected, along
- 22 with the numbered security tag number.
- 23 (3) The bill of lading shall remain with the ballots cast in <--

- 24 the election, with or without the accompanying security
- 25 <u>envelopes for the ballots, through the final ballot storage</u>
- 26 <del>location.</del> ANY BILLS OF LADING THAT ARE NOT SEALED IN A
- 27 TRANSPORTATION OR STORAGE CONTAINER SHALL BE KEPT IN ACCORDANCE
- 28 WITH THE COUNTY'S BALLOT SECURITY PROCEDURES AND SHALL BE
- 29 AVAILABLE FOR INSPECTION BY A POLL WATCHER.
- 30 (d) If the numbered security tag is broken, IT SHOULD BE <--

- 1 STORED WITH THE BILL OF LADING AND the bill of lading shall be
- 2 marked with the:
- 3 (1) location, date and time regarding the incident;
- 4 (2) reason for the incident;
- 5 (3) broken numbered security tag number; and
- 6 (4) newly affixed numbered security tag number.
- 7 (e) If a ballot storage location is monitored by staff, the
- 8 staff TRANSPORTATION CONTAINER CONTAINING BALLOTS IS MOVED,
- 9 DOCUMENTATION SHALL BE KEPT WITH THE CONTAINER, INCLUDING THE
- 10 NAME OF THE INDIVIDUAL WHO HANDLED OR HAD CUSTODY OF THE
- 11 TRANSPORTATION CONTAINER. THE INDIVIDUAL shall record the
- 12 <u>location</u>, <u>date</u>, <u>time</u> <u>and</u> <u>numbered</u> <u>security</u> <u>tag</u> <u>number</u> <u>regarding</u>
- 13 the ballots cast in the election. STORAGE AND MAINTENANCE OF <--
- 14 CHAIN OF CUSTODY OF DOCUMENTS SHALL BE PRESCRIBED IN THE
- 15 <u>COUNTY'S BALLOT SECURITY PROCEDURES.</u>
- (f) A poll watcher shall be entitled to know the numbered <--
- 17 security tag numbers and location of the stored ballots cast in
- 18 the election, NUMBER OF TRANSPORTATION AND STORAGE CONTAINERS <--
- 19 CONTAINING BALLOTS IN A GIVEN ELECTION, which are waiting to be
- 20 counted PRECANVASSED, CANVASSED or stored after counting. <--
- 21 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
