14	Section 1. Section 813 of the act of July 19, 1979 (P.L.130,
15	No.48), known as the Health Care Facilities Act, is amended by

19	(c) Long-term care nursing facilities
20	(1) In addition to an inspection under subsection (a),
21	the department shall conduct, on an annual basis, at least
22	one unannounced inspection of each long-term care nursing

- 1 <u>facility. The inspection shall be in addition to and at a</u>
- 2 <u>different time than an inspection required for licensure or a</u>
- 3 <u>renewal of a license.</u>
- 4 (2) An inspection of a long-term care nursing facility
- 5 <u>under this section shall be conducted in a manner that</u>
- 6 respects the privacy of each patient of the facility.
- 7 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 <u>Section 822. Nursing services.</u>
- 9 <u>Notwithstanding any other law or regulation, during each 24-</u>
- 10 hour period, a long-term care nursing facility shall, when
- 11 totaled for the entire long-term care nursing facility, provide
- 12 <u>a minimum of 4.1 hours of direct general nursing care for each</u>
- 13 <u>resident of the long-term care nursing facility.</u>
- 14 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
