- 1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
- act relating to the public school system, including certain
- provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto, " in preliminary provisions, providing
- for report on academic impact of COVID-19 pandemic.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 11 section to read:
- 12 <u>Section 129. Report on Academic Impact of COVID-19</u>
- 13 Pandemic. -- (a) The Joint State Government Commission shall
- 14 conduct a study and issue reports under subsection (b) on the
- 15 <u>academic impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on students in school</u>
- 16 entities, which shall include the methods of instruction which
- 17 <u>are most successful for students.</u>
- 18 (b) The reports shall be submitted as follows:
- 19 (1) An initial report shall be submitted within thirty (30)
- 20 days of the effective date of this section.

- 1 (2) An interim report shall be submitted within sixty (60)
- 2 days after the submission of the initial report under paragraph
- 3 (1).
- 4 (3) A final report shall be submitted within sixty (60) days
- 5 after the submission of the interim report under paragraph (2).
- 6 (c) The reports shall be submitted to the chair and minority
- 7 chair of the Education Committee of the Senate and the chair and
- 8 minority chair of the Education Committee of the House of
- 9 Representatives.
- 10 (d) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 11 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless
- 12 the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 13 "COVID-19 pandemic." As identified in the proclamation of
- 14 disaster emergency issued by the Governor on March 6, 2020,
- 15 published at 50 Pa.B. 1644 (March 21, 2020), and any renewal of
- 16 <u>the state of disaster emergency.</u>
- 17 <u>"School entity." A school district, intermediate unit, area</u>
- 18 career and technical school, charter school, regional charter
- 19 <u>school or cyber charter school</u>.
- 20 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
