- 4 (1) Within 45 days of the effective date of this

- 7 <u>COVID-19, including the administration of the vaccine to</u>
- 8 individuals by members of the Pennsylvania National Guard.

- 29 <u>(3) CRITICAL MISSIONS OF THE PENNSYLVANIA NATIONAL</u>
- 30 GUARD, INCLUDING THE DEPLOYMENT OF MEMBERS TO SKILLED NURSING

- 1 FACILITIES TO COMBAT OUTBREAKS OF COVID-19.
- 2 (4) CURRENT AND ANTICIPATED ALLOCATIONS OF ANY VACCINE
- FOR COVID-19 AVAILABLE TO THE COMMONWEALTH.
- 4 (5) FEDERAL GUIDANCE ON THE USE OF THE NATIONAL GUARD
- 5 FOR THE PURPOSES UNDER THIS SUBSECTION.
- 6 (E) DEFINITIONS.--AS USED IN THIS SECTION, THE FOLLOWING
- 7 WORDS AND PHRASES SHALL HAVE THE MEANINGS GIVEN TO THEM IN THIS
- 8 SUBSECTION UNLESS THE CONTEXT CLEARLY INDICATES OTHERWISE:
- 9 "REGION." EACH REGION OF THE COMMONWEALTH, AS IDENTIFIED BY
- 10 THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH.
- "VIRUS." A VIRUS OR INFECTIOUS DISEASE, IDENTIFIED BY THE
- 12 UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES OR THE
