AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in riot, disorderly conduct and 2 related offenses, further providing for the offense of 3 neglect of animal and for the offense of tethering of 4 unattended dog. 5 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 5532(a) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania 8 Consolidated Statutes is amended and the section is amended by 10 adding subsections to read: 11 § 5532. Neglect of animal. 12 Offense defined .-- A person commits an offense if the person fails to provide for the basic needs of each domestic 13 animal to which the person has a duty of care, whether belonging 14 15 to himself or otherwise, including any of the following: 16 (1)Necessary sustenance and potable water. 17 (2) Access to clean and sanitary shelter [and] which must provide protection from the weather[. The shelter must 18

be sufficient to permit the animal to retain body heat] and

2	(3) Necessary veterinary care.
3	(a.1) Requirements for dogs The following shall be
4	provided for a dog that stays outside and unattended for more
5	than 30 minutes during any period of a day:
6	(1) A shelter, which shall:
7	(i) be moistureproof and windproof and of a suitable
8	size to accommodate the dog, allowing for freedom of
9	movement to make normal postural adjustments, including
10	the ability to stand, turn around and lie down with limbs
11	<pre>outstretched;</pre>
12	(ii) be made of durable material with a solid,
13	moistureproof floor raised at least three inches from the
14	ground;
15	(iii) have a roof which shall extend eight inches
16	over the doorway and not permit rain to enter inside the
17	<pre>shelter; and</pre>
18	(iv) not be constructed of metal or any material
19	that readily conducts heat or cold.
20	(2) Between November 1 and March 31 of any year, a
21	shelter described under paragraph (1) which shall:
22	(i) have a windbreak at the entrance;
23	(ii) contain a sufficient quantity of suitable,
24	clean bedding material consisting of straw, cedar
25	shavings or the equivalent;
26	(iii) provide insulation appropriate to local
27	climate conditions and sufficient to protect against cold
28	and dampness; and
29	(iv) not utilize hay, blankets, rags or other
30	material that retains moisture for bedding.

- 1 (3) Between May 1 and October 31 of any year, one or
- 2 <u>more areas of shade by natural or artificial means large</u>
- 3 enough to accommodate the entire body of the dog at one time.
- 4 <u>A shaded area must be separate from a shelter required under</u>
- 5 this subsection.
- 6 (a.2) Extreme weather for dogs.--
- 7 (1) No person who has the duty of care of a dog may
- 8 <u>knowingly leave the dog outside and beyond the visual range</u>
- 9 and physical presence of the person, regardless of access to
- an outdoor shelter, for more than 15 consecutive minutes in
- an area in which a severe weather advisory or warning has
- been issued by the National Weather Service or if the
- 13 <u>temperature is below 32 degrees Fahrenheit or above 90</u>
- 14 degrees Fahrenheit.
- 15 (2) This subsection shall include, but not be limited
- to, a dog in a fenced-in yard, in a kennel or tethered.

- 18 Section 2. Section 5536(a)(1)(iv) and (b) of Title 18 are
- 19 amended to read:
- 20 § 5536. Tethering of unattended dog.
- 21 (a) Presumptions.--
- 22 (1) Tethering an unattended dog out of doors for less
- than nine hours within a 24-hour period when all of the
- following conditions are present shall create a rebuttable
- 25 presumption that a dog has not been the subject of neglect
- within the meaning of section 5532 (relating to neglect of
- 27 animal):

- 29 (iv) The dog has not been tethered for longer than
- 30 [30] 15 minutes in temperatures above 90 or below 32

- degrees Fahrenheit.

- 3 (b) Construction. -- [This] While subject to the provisions of
- 4 <u>subsection (a), this</u> section shall not be construed to prohibit
- 5 any of the following:
- 6 (1) Tethering a dog while actively engaged in lawful
- 7 hunting, exhibition, performance events or field training.
- 8 (2) Tethering a hunting, sporting or sledding dog breed
- 9 where tethering is integral to the training, conditioning or
- 10 purpose of the dog.
- 11 (3) Tethering a dog in compliance with the requirements
- of a camping or recreational area.
- 13 (4) Tethering a dog for a period of time, not to exceed
- one hour, reasonably necessary for the dog or person to
- 15 complete a temporary task.
- 16 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
