AN ACT

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1	Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2	Statutes, in snowmobiles and all-terrain vehicles, further
3	providing for short title of chapter, for definitions, for
4	restricted accounts, for registration of dealers, for
5	registration of snowmobile or ATV, for limited registration
6	of snowmobile or ATV, for certificate of title for snowmobile
7	or ATV, for transfer to or from dealer, for transfer of
8	snowmobile or ATV by operation of law, for issuance of new
9	certificate following transfer, for suspension and
10	cancellation of certificate of title, for application for
11	certificate of title by agent, for perfection of security
12	interest in a snowmobile or ATV, for satisfaction of security
13	interest, for release of security interest, for assignment by
14	secured party of security interest, for exemptions, for
15	snowmobile or ATV purchased from dealer, for fees, for
16	records, for Snowmobile and ATV Advisory Committee, for
17	operation on streets and highways, for designation of
18	snowmobile and ATV roads, for special snowmobile and ATV
19	events, for operation on private or State property, for
20	operation by persons under age sixteen, for operation in safe
21	manner, for additional limitations on operation, for
22	accidents and accident reports, for liability of owner for
23	negligence, for liability insurance, for head lamps and tail
24	lamps, for brakes, for mufflers and sound control, for
25	enforcement personnel and procedures and for penalties for
26	violation of chapter; and making editorial changes.

27 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

28 hereby enacts as follows:

6	Section 2. Section 7701 of Title 75 is amended to read:
7	§ 7701. Short title of chapter.
8	This chapter shall be known and may be cited as the
9	Snowmobile [and], All-Terrain Vehicle and Off-Highway Motorcycle
10	Law.
11	Section 3. The definition of "all-terrain vehicle" or "ATV"
12	in section 7702 of Title 75 is amended and the section is
13	amended by adding a definition to read:
14	§ 7702. Definitions.
15	The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
16	shall have, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, the
17	meanings given to them in this section:
18	"All-terrain vehicle" or "ATV." A motorized off-highway
19	vehicle which travels on three or more off-highway tires and
20	which has:
21	(1) a maximum width of 50 inches and a maximum dry
22	weight of 1,200 pounds; or
23	(2) a width which exceeds 50 inches or a dry weight
24	which exceeds 1,200 pounds.
25	ATV's described in paragraph (1) may be referred to as Class I
26	ATV's, and ATV's described in paragraph (2) may be referred to
27	as Class II ATV's. This term does not include snowmobiles,
28	[trail bikes,] <u>off-highway motorcycles,</u> motorboats, golf carts,
29	aircraft, dune buggies, automobiles, construction machines,
30	trucks or home utility machines; military, fire, emergency and
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1 law enforcement vehicles; implements of husbandry; multipurpose 2 agricultural vehicles; vehicles used by the department; or any 3 vehicle that is or is required to be registered under Chapter 13 4 (relating to registration of vehicles). In addition, this term 5 does not include off-road motor vehicles used exclusively as 6 utility vehicles for agricultural or business operations and 7 incidentally operated or moved upon the highway.

9 <u>"Off-highway motorcycle" or "OHM." A motor vehicle used off</u>
10 <u>the roads or highways of this Commonwealth that has a seat or</u>
11 <u>saddle for the use of the rider and is designed to travel with</u>
12 <u>not more than two wheels in contact with the ground, including</u>
13 <u>dual sport motorcycles.</u>

Section 4. Sections 7706(a)(1) and (2), (b), (c) and (e) and 16 7711(a) and (e) introductory paragraph, (3) and (4) of Title 75 17 are amended to read:

18 § 7706. Restricted accounts.

19 (a) Deposit and use of moneys.--

(1) The ATV and OHM Management Restricted Account and
the Snowmobile Management Restricted Account are established
in the State Treasury. The department shall deposit the
following into the appropriate restricted account:

(i) all moneys received from the registration of and
issuance of certificates of title for snowmobiles [and],
ATV's <u>or OHM's</u> and from the issuance of vintage
snowmobile permits;

(ii) all revenue from the sale of any publications
or services relating to snowmobiles [and], ATV's and
<u>OHM's;</u>

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(iii) all fines, penalties, fees and costs assessed
 and collected as a result of enforcement activities
 conducted by the department's law enforcement personnel
 under this chapter related to violations attributed to
 ATV's <u>and OHM's</u> shall be deposited in the ATV <u>and OHM</u>
 Management Restricted Account;

(iv) all fines, penalties, fees and costs assessed
and collected as a result of enforcement activities
conducted by the department's law enforcement personnel
under this chapter related to violations attributed to
snowmobiles shall be deposited in the Snowmobile
Management Restricted Account; and

(v) all refunds of gas taxes generated under section 9017(d.1) (relating to refunds) shall be deposited in the two restricted accounts on a proportional basis of the activity that generated those taxes.

17 The department shall draw moneys from the respective (2)18 restricted accounts for use in performing any activities 19 necessary to carry out the purposes of this chapter, 20 including registration and certificate of title activities, 21 training, education, enforcement activities, construction and 22 maintenance of snowmobile [and], ATV and OHM trails and 23 acquisition of equipment, supplies and interests in land. All 24 moneys deposited in these accounts shall remain in them to be 25 used as specified in this section. With the exception of 26 trails used by [both] snowmobiles [and], ATV's and OHM's, 27 under no circumstances shall the department expend any moneys 28 from the accounts except for the activity that generated 29 those accounts.

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1 (b) Grant-in-aid.--The department shall, upon written 2 application and subsequent approval, grant money from the 3 restricted accounts:

4 (1) To municipalities, profit and nonprofit
5 organizations in connection with snowmobile [and], ATV and
6 <u>OHM</u> use on lands [not owned by the Commonwealth] for the
7 following:

8 (i) Plans, specifications and engineering surveys. 9 (ii) Fees and costs related to the preparation or 10 performance of right-of-way lease agreements.

11

(iii) Land acquisition.

12 (iv) Construction, maintenance and rehabilitation of 13 trails and other facilities for snowmobiles [and], ATV's 14 and OHM's.

15 (2) To municipalities and profit and nonprofit
16 organizations for equipment, training and education
17 activities relating to snowmobile [and], ATV and OHM use.

18 (3) To profit and nonprofit organizations for the 19 maintenance, rehabilitation and construction of snowmobile 20 [and], ATV and OHM trails on land owned by the Commonwealth. 21 * * *

(c) Audit of moneys.--The restricted accounts shall be audited every two years. Copies of the audit shall be provided to the Snowmobile [and], ATV and OHM Advisory Committee, the Appropriations Committee of the Senate and the Appropriations Committee of the House of Representatives. Copies shall also be posted and maintained on the department's publicly accessible Internet website.

30 (e) Definition.--For purposes of this section, "all-terrain 20210HB0478PN2082 - 5 -

1 vehicle" or "ATV" shall also include any self-propelled vehicle 2 which is manufactured for sale or operation primarily on off-3 highway trails or off-highway competition and only incidentally operated on public highways. This term includes OHM's. This term 4 shall not include a snowmobile or other self-propelled vehicles 5 manufactured for off-highway use exclusively designed for travel 6 on snow or ice, steered by skis or runners and supported in 7 8 whole or in part by one or more skis, belts or cleats which 9 utilize an endless belt tread.

10 § 7711. Registration of dealers.

(a) General rule.--A person who is in the business of selling snowmobiles [or], ATV's <u>or OHM's</u> in this Commonwealth shall register with the department as a dealer. A person who is in the business of selling snowmobiles [or], ATV's <u>or OHM's</u> outside this Commonwealth may register with the department as a dealer.

18 (e) Use of dealer registration plates.--A dealer may operate 19 or permit to be operated within this Commonwealth a snowmobile 20 [or], ATV or OHM owned by or in the possession of the dealer if: 21 * * *

(3) There is displayed on the snowmobile [or], ATV or
 OHM in a manner prescribed by the department a valid dealer
 registration plate issued to the dealer under this section.

(4) The snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM is operated only for
the purpose of demonstration or testing in connection with
the dealer's business.

28 Section 5. Section 7711.1 heading, (a) introductory 29 paragraph, (1), (2) and (4), (b) introductory paragraph, (1) and 30 (2), (d)(2) and (f)(1), (2), (3) and (4) of Title 75 are amended

Registration of snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM. 3 (a) General rule.--Except as otherwise provided in subsection (f), it is unlawful for a person to operate or for an 4 5 owner to permit another person to operate a snowmobile [or], an ATV or an OHM unless: 6 7 There is carried on the snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM (1)8 a valid registration certificate issued therefor pursuant to 9 subsection (b). 10 There is displayed on the snowmobile a registration (2)decal, or on the ATV or OHM a registration plate, issued 11 12 therefor pursuant to subsection (b). * * * 13 14 There is displayed on the snowmobile [or], ATV or (4) 15 OHM a valid expiration sticker issued therefor pursuant to 16 subsection (b). * * * 17 18 (b) Issuance.--Upon receipt of an application therefor upon a form prescribed and furnished by the department which shall 19 20 contain information reasonably required by the department and which shall be accompanied by the required fee, the department 21 shall issue to the owner of a snowmobile [or]_ ATV or OHM: 22 23 (1)A biennial registration certificate containing the 24 registration number for the snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM and 25 the expiration date of the registration. 26 A registration decal displaying the registration (2) number for a snowmobile or a registration plate displaying 27 28 the registration number for an ATV or OHM. * * * 29 (c.1) Exception. -- OHM's registered with the Department of 30

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1 <u>Transportation do not require a registration plate.</u>

(d) Expiration of registration.--

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(2) Upon transfer of ownership of a snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM during a registration period, the registration certificate and expiration sticker shall expire. The transferor shall, within 15 days from the date of transfer, return to the department the registration certificate with the date of transfer and the name and address of the new owner endorsed on the back. If the transferor applies for registration of a different snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM and pays the required transfer fee, the transferor may be issued in the name of the transferor a registration certificate and expiration sticker for that snowmobile [or], ATV <u>or OHM</u> for the remainder of the registration period without payment of a registration fee. The registration decal or plate shall not be removed from a snowmobile [or], ATV <u>or OHM</u> upon transfer

18 to the new owner and is invalid until the new owner is issued 19 a registration certificate or limited registration

20 certificate for the snowmobile [or]_ ATV or OHM.

22 (f) Exemptions from registration.--Subsection (a) does not 23 apply if:

(1) The snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM is owned by or in
the possession of a dealer who has been issued a dealer
registration certificate, dealer registration plates and
dealer plate registration cards under section 7711 (relating
to registration of dealers), the dealer is in compliance with
section 7711 and the snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM is used in
accordance with section 7711.

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1 (2) The snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM is owned and used by 2 the United States or another state or a political subdivision 3 thereof, in which case the snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM shall 4 display the name of the owner in a manner prescribed by the 5 department.

(3) The snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM is operated on land
owned or leased by the owner or operator of the snowmobile
[or], ATV or OHM and it is not operated elsewhere within this
Commonwealth. Except as otherwise provided in this
subsection, an OHM does not need to be registered with the
department when the OHM operator is invited on the land by
the owner or lessee of the land.

13 (4) The owner of the snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM is not 14 a resident of this Commonwealth and the operator presents 15 proof that the snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM has been properly 16 registered in another jurisdiction that exempts from its 17 registration requirements persons who have obtained proper 18 registration under this chapter.

Section 6. Sections 7711.2 heading, (a) introductory
paragraph and (2), (b) and (d), 7712.1 heading, (a), (b), (c),
(d), (g), (h)(2) and (3) and (j), 7712.2(a), (b), (c)

27 § 7711.2. Limited registration of snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM.
28 (a) General rule.--It is unlawful for a person to operate or
29 for an owner to permit another person to operate a snowmobile
30 [or], ATV or OHM identified in section 7711.1(f)(3) (relating to

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1 registration of snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM) unless:

2 * * *

3 (2) There is displayed on the snowmobile a valid
4 registration decal or on the ATV <u>or OHM</u> a valid registration
5 plate issued pursuant to subsection (b).

6 * * *

7 (b) Issuance.--Upon receipt of an application therefor upon 8 a form prescribed and furnished by the department which shall 9 contain information reasonably required by the department, the 10 department shall issue to the owner of a snowmobile [or], ATV or 11 <u>OHM</u> for which limited registration is required under subsection 12 (a):

(1) A limited registration certificate containing the
 registration number for the snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM.

15 (2) A registration decal displaying the registration
16 number for a snowmobile or a registration plate displaying
17 the registration number for an ATV <u>or OHM</u>.

18 * * *

19 Transfer of ownership. -- Upon transfer of ownership of a (d) snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM for which a limited registration 20 21 certificate has been issued, the limited registration certificate shall become invalid. The transferor shall, within 22 23 15 days from the date of transfer, return to the department the 24 limited registration certificate with the date of transfer and 25 the name and address of the new owner endorsed on the back. The 26 registration decal or plate shall not be removed from the snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM upon transfer to the new owner and 27 28 is invalid until the new owner obtains a registration 29 certificate or limited registration certificate for the snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM. 30

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2 § 7712.1. Certificate of title for snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM.
3 (a) General rule.--Except as otherwise provided in
4 subsection (b), an owner of a snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM which
5 is in this Commonwealth and for which no certificate of title
6 has been issued shall apply to the department for a certificate
7 of title.

8 (b) Exemptions from titling.--No certificate of title is9 required for:

10 (1) A snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM that was registered 11 prior to the effective date of this section.

12 (2) A snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM owned by the United
13 States unless a general registration certificate has been
14 issued therefor.

15 (3) A new snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM owned by a dealer
16 before and until sale.

17 (4) A snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM owned by a nonresident 18 of this Commonwealth and not required by law to be registered 19 in this Commonwealth.

(5) A snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM owned by a resident of this Commonwealth and required by law to be registered in another state, based and used principally outside of this Commonwealth and not required by law to be registered in this Commonwealth.

25 (6) A non-street legal OHM purchased after the enactment
26 of this subsection.

(c) Contents of application.--Application for a certificate of title shall be made upon a form prescribed and furnished by the department and shall contain a full description of the snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM, date of purchase, the name and

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1 address of the owner, a statement of the title of applicant,
2 together with any other information or documents the department
3 requires to identify the snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM and to
4 enable the department to determine whether the owner is entitled
5 to a certificate of title.

6 Signing and filing of application. -- Application for a (d) 7 certificate of title shall be made within 15 days of the sale or 8 transfer of a snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM or its entry into this Commonwealth from another jurisdiction, whichever is later. The 9 10 application shall be accompanied by the required fee and any tax payable by the applicant under the laws of this Commonwealth in 11 connection with the acquisition or use of a snowmobile [or]_ ATV 12 13 or OHM or evidence to show that the tax has been paid or 14 collected. The application shall be signed and verified by oath 15 or affirmation by the applicant if a natural person; in the case 16 of an association or partnership, by a member or a partner; and in the case of a corporation, by an executive officer or person 17 18 specifically authorized by the corporation to sign the 19 application.

20 (q) Registration without certificate of title prohibited.--Except as provided in subsection (b), the department shall not 21 issue a registration certificate or limited registration 22 23 certificate for a snowmobile [or]_ ATV or OHM or a vintage 24 snowmobile permit for a vintage snowmobile unless a certificate 25 of title has been issued by the department to the owner or an 26 application for a certificate of title has been delivered by the 27 owner to the department.

(h) Refusing issuance of certificate of title.--The
department may refuse issuance of a certificate of title if it
has reasonable grounds to believe any one of the following:

* * *

2 (2) Any taxes payable under the laws of this
3 Commonwealth on or in connection with, or resulting from the
4 acquisition or use of, the snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM have
5 not been paid.

6 (3) The applicant is not the owner of the snowmobile 7 [or], ATV <u>or OHM</u>.

8

(j) Transfer of ownership of snowmobile [or]_ ATV <u>or OHM</u>.--

10 Upon the sale or transfer of ownership of a (1)11 snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM within this Commonwealth, the 12 owner shall execute an assignment and warranty of title to 13 the transferee in the space provided on the certificate of 14 title or as the department prescribes, sworn to before a 15 notary public or other officer empowered to administer oaths, 16 and deliver the certificate to the transferee at the time of 17 the delivery of the snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM.

18 (2)Except as otherwise provided in section 7715.1 19 (relating to snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM purchased from 20 dealer), the transferee shall, within 15 days of the 21 assignment of the certificate of title, apply for a new title 22 by forwarding to the department the certificate of title 23 executed as required by paragraph (1), a properly completed 24 application for certificate of title, sworn to before a 25 notary public or other officer empowered to administer oaths, and such other forms as the department may require. 26 * * * 27

28 § 7712.2. Transfer to or from dealer.

29 (a) Transfer to dealer.--If a dealer acquires a snowmobile
30 [or], ATV or OHM for the purpose of resale, a certificate of

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1 title need not be applied for as provided for in section 7712.1
2 (relating to certificate of title for snowmobile [or], ATV or
3 <u>OHM</u>), but the dealer shall, within seven days from the date of
4 acquisition, forward to the department, upon a form prescribed
5 and furnished by the department, notification of the acquisition
6 of the snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM.

7 (b) Execution and display of notice of transfer. -- A dealer 8 making notification pursuant to subsection (a) shall execute at least three copies of the notification, the original of which 9 10 shall be forwarded to the department, one copy to accompany the snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM in any subsequent transfer and one 11 copy to be retained by the dealer for at least one year after a 12 subsequent transfer, to be exhibited, with the assigned 13 14 certificate of title, upon request of a police officer or 15 authorized department employee.

16 (c) Transfer from dealer.--Except as otherwise provided in 17 subsection (a), if a dealer transfers the dealer's interest in a 18 snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM:

19 * * *

(d) Exception for repossessed snowmobiles [or], ATV's or
<u>OHM's</u>.--This section does not apply to a snowmobile [or], ATV or
<u>OHM</u> repossessed upon default of performance of a lease, contract
of conditional sale or similar agreement.

25 § 7712.3. Transfer of snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM by operation 26 of law.

(a) General rule.--If the interest of an owner in a
snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM passes to another other than by
voluntary transfer, the transferee shall, except as otherwise
provided, promptly mail or deliver to the department the last

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1 certificate of title, if available, and shall apply for a new 2 certificate of title on a form prescribed and furnished by the 3 department. The application shall be accompanied by such 4 instruments or documents of authority, or certified copies 5 thereof, as may be sufficient or required by law to evidence or 6 effect a transfer of title or interest in or to chattels in such 7 case.

8 * * *

9 (c) Surrender of certificate. -- A person holding a 10 certificate of title, whose interest in a snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM has been extinguished or transferred other than by 11 voluntary transfer, shall immediately surrender the certificate 12 13 of title to the person to whom the right to possession of the snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM has passed. Upon request of the 14 15 department, such person shall mail or deliver the certificate to 16 the department. Delivery of the certificate pursuant to the request of the department does not affect the rights of the 17 18 person surrendering the certificate.

19 § 7712.5. Issuance of new certificate following transfer.
20 * * *

(c) Filing and retention of surrendered certificate.--The 21 department shall file and retain for five years a surrendered 22 23 certificate of title, or a copy, in such a manner as to permit 24 the tracing of title of the snowmobile [or]_ ATV or OHM. 25 § 7712.6. Suspension and cancellation of certificate of title. 26 (a) Return of new snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM.--The department may cancel the certificate of title issued for a new 27 28 snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM if it is shown by satisfactory evidence that the snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM has been returned 29 to the dealer from whom obtained. 30

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1 (b) Snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM sold to nonresidents.--The 2 department may cancel a certificate of title for a snowmobile 3 [or], ATV or OHM sold to a resident of another state or foreign 4 country if the snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM is to be registered 5 in the other jurisdiction.

6 * * *

7 § 7712.7. Application for certificate of title by agent.

8 (a) Authorization to apply.--No person may apply for a certificate of title on behalf of another person unless 9 10 authorization to do so is in effect and is verified by oath or affirmation of the other person, made, except as between lessors 11 and fleet owners as lessees, not more than 15 days before the 12 13 application is received by the department. A lessor may 14 authorize a fleet owner to apply for a certificate of title for a leased snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM for a period of up to one 15 16 year.

17 * * *

18 (c) Persons authorized to hold certificate. -- No person may receive, obtain or hold a certificate of title recorded in the 19 20 name of another person for the other person who is not in the regular employ of, or not a member of the family of, the other 21 person, unless the person receiving, obtaining or holding the 22 23 certificate of title has a valid undischarged security interest 24 recorded in the department against the snowmobile [or], ATV or 25 <u>OHM</u> represented by the certificate of title.

26 * * *

27 § 7712.8. Perfection of security interest in a snowmobile [or],
28 ATV or OHM.

(a) Applicability of section.--Except as otherwise provided
in 13 Pa.C.S. §§ 9311(d) (relating to perfection of security

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1 interests in property subject to certain statutes, regulations 2 and treaties), 9315(c) and (d) (relating to secured party's 3 rights on disposition of collateral and in proceeds) and 9316(d) 4 and (e) (relating to effect of change in governing law), this 5 section provides the exclusive method of perfecting a security 6 interest in a snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM for which a 7 certificate of title is required under this subchapter.

8 Snowmobiles [or] ATV's or OHM's without Pennsylvania (b) 9 certificate of title.--If an owner creates a security interest in a snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM for which a certificate of 10 title has not been issued by the department, the owner shall, at 11 the request of the secured party, promptly execute an 12 13 application for a certificate of title on a form prescribed by 14 the department showing the name and address of the secured 15 party. The owner shall tender the application, the existing 16 certificate of title, if any, and the required fee to the department. A security interest in a snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM_ 17 18 is perfected at the time that such application, existing certificate of title, if any, and required fee are received by 19 20 the department.

21 Snowmobiles [or] ATV's or OHM's with Pennsylvania (C) certificate of title.--If an owner creates a security interest 22 23 in a snowmobile [or], ATV or OHM for which a certificate of 24 title has been issued by the department, the owner shall, at the request of the secured party, promptly execute an application on 25 26 a form prescribed by the department showing the name and address of the secured party. The owner shall tender the certificate of 27 28 title, together with the application and the required fee, to 29 the department. 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1 shall not exceed 96dbA, or decibels, when measured at 20 inches.
