A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 2 3	Proposing separate and distinct amendments to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, providing for an economic bill of rights.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby resolves as follows:
6	Section 1. The following separate and distinct amendments to
7	the Constitution of Pennsylvania are proposed in accordance with
8	Article XI:
9	That Article I be amended by adding a section to read:
10	<u>§ 29. Economic bill of rights.</u>
11	(a) The people shall have the right to a living wage to
12	reasonably support one's self and their family.
13	(b) The people shall have the right to affordable and
14	accessible health care and the opportunity to achieve and enjoy
15	good physical and mental health.
16	(c) The people shall have the right to safe, efficient and
17	reliable transportation infrastructure.
18	(d) The people shall have the right to safe and healthy

1 working conditions.

2 Section 2. (a) Upon the first passage by the General Assembly of these proposed separate and distinct constitutional 3 4 amendments, the Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the advertising requirements of 5 6 section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the required advertisements to two newspapers in 7 every county in which such newspapers are published in 8 9 sufficient time after passage of these proposed constitutional 10 amendments.

11 (b) Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of these proposed separate and distinct constitutional amendments, the 12 Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to 13 comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article 14 15 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the 16 required advertisements to two newspapers in every county in which such newspapers are published in sufficient time after 17 passage of these proposed separate and distinct constitutional 18 19 amendments. The Secretary of the Commonwealth shall submit these 20 proposed separate and distinct constitutional amendments under 21 section 1 of this resolution to the qualified electors of this 22 Commonwealth as four separate and distinct ballot questions at 23 the first primary, general or municipal election which meets the 24 requirements of and is in conformance with section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and which occurs at least 25 three months after these proposed separate and distinct 26 constitutional amendments are passed by the General Assembly. 27
