- 3 The following words and phrases when used in this subchapter
- 4 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 5 <u>context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 6 "Municipal corporation." A city, county, borough, township,
- 7 <u>incorporated town, home rule municipality, optional plan</u>
- 8 <u>municipality or optional charter municipality.</u>
- 9 "Public notice." Notice published once each week for two
- 10 successive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation.
- 11 § 5212. Sale or lease of water or sewer system.
- 12 In addition to the provisions of 65 Pa.C.S. Ch. 7 (relating
- 13 to open meetings), prior to entering into an agreement to sell
- 14 or lease a water or sewer system owned or operated by a
- 15 <u>municipal corporation or to sell or lease a water or sewer</u>
- 16 system currently owned or operated by a municipal authority that
- 17 would require dissolution by the municipal corporation, the
- 18 municipal corporation shall hold at least one advertised public
- 19 meeting, not more than 60 days nor fewer than seven days prior
- 20 to entering into the agreement with the potential purchaser or
- 21 lessee, and shall provide public notice of the meeting in all
- 22 municipalities served by the water or sewer system. The
- 23 potential purchaser or lessee shall attend the meeting.
- 24 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
