## AN ACT

Amending the act of September 30, 1983 (P.L.160, No.39), 1 entitled "An act establishing salaries and compensation of 2 certain public officials including justices and judges of 3 Statewide courts, judges of courts of common pleas, judges of the Philadelphia Municipal Court, judges of the Philadelphia Traffic Court, district justices and the Governor, the Lieutenant Governor, the State Treasurer, the Auditor 7 General, the Attorney General and certain other State 8 officers and the salary and certain expenses of the members of the General Assembly; and repealing certain inconsistent 10 acts," further providing for judicial salaries, for compensation of Governor and Lieutenant Governor, State 11 12 Treasurer, Auditor General, Attorney General, Commissioners 13 of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission and heads of departments, for members of the general assembly and for 15 cost-of-living adjustment hiatus. 16 17 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 18 hereby enacts as follows: 19 Section 1. Sections 2.1(i), 3(e), 4(d) and (d.1) and 5.3(a)of the act of September 30, 1983 (P.L.160, No.39), known as the 20 Public Official Compensation Law, amended or added October 16, 22 2020, (P.L.706, No.79), is amended to read: Section 2.1. Judicial salaries. 23

(i) Annual cost-of-living adjustment. --

- 2 Except as provided under paragraph (2), beginning 3 January 1, 1997, and each January 1 thereafter, the annual salaries under subsections (a) through (h) shall be increased 4 5 by the percentage change in the Consumer Price Index for All 6 Urban Consumers (CPI-U) for the Pennsylvania, New Jersey, 7 Delaware and Maryland area for the most recent 12-month 8 period for which figures have been officially reported by the 9 United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics immediately prior to the date the adjustment is due to take 10 11 effect. The percentage increase and salary amounts shall be 12 determined prior to the annual effective date of the 13 adjustment by the Supreme Court and shall be published in the 14 Pennsylvania Bulletin by the Court Administrator of Pennsylvania within 20 days of the date the determination is 15 16 made.
  - (2) (i) The annual salaries under this section may not be increased by an annual cost-of-living adjustment under paragraph (1) for the annual period beginning January 1, 2021, and ending December 31, 2021. Notice of the provisions of this subsection shall be transmitted to the Legislative Reference Bureau for publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin prior to December 1, 2020.
  - (ii) The annual salaries under this section may not be increased by an annual cost-of-living adjustment under paragraph (1) for the annual period beginning January 1, 2022, and ending December 31, 2022. Notice of the provisions of this subsection shall be transmitted to the Legislative Reference Bureau for publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin prior to December 1, 2021.

1 (i) The annual salaries for individuals subject to 2 42 Pa.C.S. § 1741(a)(1) or (2) (relating to compensation 3 of judges) may not be increased by a cost-of-living adjustment under 42 Pa.C.S. § 1741(b) for the annual 4 5 period beginning January 1, 2021, and ending December 31, 2021. Notice of the provisions of this subsection shall 6 7 be transmitted to the Legislative Reference Bureau for 8 publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin prior to 9 December 1, 2020.

(ii) The annual salaries for individuals subject to

42 Pa.C.S. § 1741(a)(1) or (2) may not be increased by a

cost-of-living adjustment under 42 Pa.C.S. § 1741(b) for

the annual period beginning January 1, 2022, and ending

December 31, 2022. Notice of the provisions of this

subsection shall be transmitted to the Legislative

Reference Bureau for publication in the Pennsylvania

Bulletin prior to December 1, 2021.

Section 3. Compensation of Governor and Lieutenant Governor;

State Treasurer; Auditor General; Attorney General;

Commissioners of the Pennsylvania Public Utility

Commission; and heads of departments.

- (e) Annual cost-of-living adjustment. --
- 24 (1) Except as provided under paragraph (2), beginning
  25 January 1, 1997, and each January 1 thereafter, the stated
  26 annual salaries of the Governor and Lieutenant Governor, the
  27 State Treasurer, the Auditor General, the Attorney General
  28 and the heads of the departments and members of boards and
  29 commissions denoted herein shall be increased by an annual
  30 cost-of-living increase calculated by applying the percentage

1 change in the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers

2 (CPI-U) for the Pennsylvania, New Jersey, Delaware and

3 Maryland area, for the most recent 12-month period for which

figures have been officially reported by the United States

Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics immediately

prior to the date the adjustment is due to take effect, to

the then current salary amounts authorized. The percentage

increase and the salary amounts shall be determined by the

9 Governor prior to the annual effective date of the adjustment

and shall be published by the Secretary of the Budget in the

Pennsylvania Bulletin within ten days of the date the

12 determination is made.

- (2) (i) The stated annual salaries of the Governor and Lieutenant Governor, the State Treasurer, the Auditor General, the Attorney General and the heads of the departments and members of boards and commissions may not be increased by an annual cost-of-living adjustment under paragraph (1) for the annual period beginning January 1, 2021, and ending December 31, 2021. Notice of the provisions of this subsection shall be transmitted to the Legislative Reference Bureau for publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin prior to December 1, 2020.
- 23 (ii) The stated annual salaries of the Governor and 24 Lieutenant Governor, the State Treasurer, the Auditor 25 General, the Attorney General and the heads of the 26 departments and members of boards and commissions may not 27 be increased by an annual cost-of-living adjustment under\_ paragraph (1) for the annual period beginning January 1, 28 2022, and ending December 31, 2022. Notice of the 29 provisions of this subsection shall be transmitted to the 30

- 7 Except as provided under paragraph (2), for the 12-(1)8 month period beginning December 1, 1997, through November 30, 9 1998, and for each like 12-month period thereafter, the 10 salary of the members of the General Assembly shall be 11 increased by an annual cost-of-living adjustment calculated 12 by applying the percentage change in the Consumer Price Index 13 for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) for the Pennsylvania, New 14 Jersey, Delaware and Maryland area, for the most recent 12-15 month period for which figures have been officially reported 16 by the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor 17 Statistics immediately prior to the date the adjustment is 18 due to take effect, to the then current salary amounts. The 19 percentage increase and the new salary amounts shall be 20 determined jointly by the Chief Clerk of the Senate and the 21 Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives prior to the 22 annual effective date of the adjustment and shall be 23 published by them in the Pennsylvania Bulletin within ten 24 days of the date such determination is made.
  - (2) (i) The salary of the members of the General
    Assembly may not be increased by an annual cost-of-living
    adjustment under paragraph (1) for the period beginning
    December 1, 2020, through November 30, 2021. Notice of
    the provisions of this subsection shall be transmitted to

- cost-of-living adjustment for the period beginning January 1,
- 27 2022, and ending December 31, 2022.

- 29 Section 2. The following shall apply:
- 30 (1) Except as provided under paragraph (2), the

- 1 provisions of this act are not severable.
- 2 (2) The amendment of section 2.1(i) of the act and
- 3 section 3 of this act shall be severable from the remainder
- 4 of this act.
- 5 Section 3. Repeals are as follows:
- 6 (1) The General Assembly declares that the repeal under
- 7 paragraph (2) is necessary to effectuate the amendment of
- 8 section 2.1(i) of the act.
- 9 (2) 42 Pa.C.S. § 1741(b) is repealed insofar as it is
- inconsistent with the amendment of section 2.1(i) of the act.
- 11 Section 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
