## AN ACT

Amending the act of April 12, 1951 (P.L.90, No.21), entitled "An act relating to alcoholic liquors, alcohol and malt and 2 brewed beverages; amending, revising, consolidating and 3 changing the laws relating thereto; regulating and restricting the manufacture, purchase, sale, possession, 5 consumption, importation, transportation, furnishing, holding 6 in bond, holding in storage, traffic in and use of alcoholic 7 liquors, alcohol and malt and brewed beverages and the 8 9 persons engaged or employed therein; defining the powers and duties of the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board; providing 10 for the establishment and operation of State liquor stores, 11 for the payment of certain license fees to the respective 12 municipalities and townships, for the abatement of certain 13 nuisances and, in certain cases, for search and seizure 14 without warrant; prescribing penalties and forfeitures; 15 providing for local option, and repealing existing laws," in licenses and regulations, liquor, alcohol and malt and brewed 16 17 beverages, providing for safekeeping during 2020 disaster 18 19 emergency. 20 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 21 22 Section 1. The act of April 12, 1951 (P.L.90, No.21), known 23 as the Liquor Code, is amended by adding a section to read: 24 Section 462.1. Safekeeping During 2020 Disaster Emergency .--In addition to the authority provided by section 462 and 25

notwithstanding any other provision of this act to the contrary,

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- 1 the board shall be authorized to engage in the following during
- 2 the proclamation of disaster emergency issued by the Governor on
- 3 March 6, 2020, published at 50 Pa.B. 1644 (March 21, 2020), and
- 4 <u>any renewal of the state of disaster emergency:</u>
- 5 (1) The board shall provide any club or catering club
- 6 <u>license that was in safekeeping at any time during the disaster</u>
- 7 <u>emergency</u>, an additional year of safekeeping. The license shall
- 8 not be subject to any renewal, validation or late fees that
- 9 would otherwise be due during this additional year, but the
- 10 <u>licensee shall otherwise file any renewal or validation that</u>
- 11 becomes due. The additional year of safekeeping shall be
- 12 construed to have started on the effective date of this section.
- 13 The additional year of safekeeping is in addition to the two
- 14 years authorized under section 474.
- 15 (2) The board shall provide any restaurant, eating place
- 16 retail dispenser, hotel, importing distributor and distributor
- 17 license that was in safekeeping at any time during the disaster
- 18 <u>emergency declaration</u>, an additional year of safekeeping. The
- 19 license shall not be subject to any renewal, validation, late or
- 20 <u>safekeeping fees that would otherwise be due during this</u>
- 21 <u>additional year, but the licensee shall otherwise file any</u>
- 22 <u>renewal or validation that becomes due. The additional year of</u>
- 23 safekeeping shall be construed to have started on the effective
- 24 date of this section.
- 25 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
