AN ACT

1 Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), entitled
 2 "An act relating to the finances of the State government;
 3 providing for cancer control, prevention and research, for
 4 ambulatory surgical center data collection, for the Joint
 5 Underwriting Association, for entertainment business
 6 financial management firms, for private dam financial
 7 assurance and for reinstatement of item vetoes; providing for
 8 the settlement, assessment, collection, and lien of taxes,
 9 bonus, and all other accounts due the Commonwealth, the
 10 collection and recovery of fees and other money or property
 11 due or belonging to the Commonwealth, or any agency thereof,
 12 including escheated property and the proceeds of its sale,
 13 the custody and disbursement or other disposition of funds
 14 and securities belonging to or in the possession of the
 15 Commonwealth, and the settlement of claims against the
 16 Commonwealth, the resettlement of accounts and appeals to the
 17 courts, refunds of moneys erroneously paid to the
 18 Commonwealth, auditing the accounts of the Commonwealth and
 19 all agencies thereof, of all public officers collecting
 20 moneys payable to the Commonwealth, or any agency thereof,
 21 and all receipts of appropriations from the Commonwealth,
 22 authorizing the Commonwealth to issue tax anticipation notes
 23 to defray current expenses, implementing the provisions of
 24 section 7(a) of Article VIII of the Constitution of
 25 Pennsylvania authorizing and restricting the incurring of
 26 certain debt and imposing penalties; affecting every
 27 department, board, commission, and officer of the State
 28 government, every political subdivision of the State, and
 29 certain officers of such subdivisions, every person,
 30 association, and corporation required to pay, assess, or
 31 collect taxes, or to make returns or reports under the laws

1 imposing taxes for State purposes, or to pay license fees or
2 other moneys to the Commonwealth, or any agency thereof,
3 every State depository and every debtor or creditor of the
4 Commonwealth," in general budget implementation, repealing
5 provisions relating to Joint Legislative Air and Water
6 Pollution Control and Conservation Committee; and making a
7 related repeal.

8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
9 hereby enacts as follows:

10 Section 1. Section 1799.9-E of the act of April 9, 1929
11 (P.L.343, No.176), known as The Fiscal Code, is repealed:

12 [Section 1799.9-E. Joint Legislative Air and Water Pollution
13 Control and Conservation Committee.

14 (a) Termination.--The Joint Legislative Air and Water
15 Pollution Control and Conservation Committee established under
16 the act of January 19, 1967 (1968 P.L.1022, No.448), entitled,
17 "An act creating a Joint Legislative Air and Water Pollution
18 Control and Conservation Committee, providing for the terms and
19 appointment of members and for organization of the committee and
20 employment of personnel, providing for study of air and water
21 pollution laws and their enforcement, providing for information
22 and assistance from other agencies of government, and making an
23 appropriation," shall terminate July 1, 2021.

24 (b) (Reserved).]

25 Section 2. Repeals are as follows:

26 (1) The General Assembly finds that the repeal under
27 paragraph (2) is necessary to effectuate this act.

28 (2) Section 24(1) and (2) of the act of June 28, 2019
29 (P.L.173, No.20), are repealed.

30 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
