AN ACT

- Amending the act of May 22, 1951 (P.L.317, No.69), entitled "An act relating to the practice of professional nursing; providing for the licensing of nurses and for the revocation and suspension of such licenses, subject to appeal, and for their reinstatement; providing for the renewal of such licenses; regulating nursing in general; prescribing 5 6 penalties and repealing certain laws," further providing for definitions and for registered nurse, clinical nurse 7 specialist, use of title and abbreviation and providing for 9 advanced practice registered nurse-certified registered nurse 10 anesthetist. 11 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 13 hereby enacts as follows: 14 Section 1. Section 2 of the act of May 22, 1951 (P.L.317, 15 No.69), known as The Professional Nursing Law, is amended by 16 adding a clause to read: 17 Section 2. Definitions .-- When used in this act, the 18 following words and phrases shall have the following meanings 19 unless the context provides otherwise: 20
- 21 (16) "Advanced practice registered nurse-certified

- 1 <u>registered nurse anesthetist" means a registered nurse licensed</u>
- 2 in this Commonwealth who is certified by the State Board of
- 3 Nursing as an advanced practice registered nurse certified
- 4 <u>registered nurse.</u>
- 5 Section 2. Section 3 of the act is amended to read:
- 6 Section 3. [Registered Nurse, Clinical Nurse Specialist,]
- 7 Use of Title and Abbreviation ["R.N." or "C.N.S."] "R.N.,"
- 8 <u>"C.N.S.," "C.R.N.A." or "A.P.R.N."</u>; Credentials; Fraud.--(a)
- 9 Any person who holds a license to practice professional nursing
- 10 in this Commonwealth, or who is maintained on inactive status in
- 11 accordance with section 11 of this act, shall have the right to
- 12 use the titles "nurse" and "registered nurse" and the
- 13 abbreviation "R.N." No other person shall engage in the practice
- 14 of professional nursing or use the titles "nurse" or "registered
- 15 nurse" or the abbreviation "R.N." to indicate that the person
- 16 using the same is a registered nurse, except that the title
- 17 "nurse" also may be used by a person licensed under the
- 18 provisions of the act of March 2, 1956 (1955 P.L.1211, No.376),
- 19 known as the "Practical Nurse Law." No person shall sell or
- 20 fraudulently obtain or fraudulently furnish any nursing diploma,
- 21 license, record, or registration or aid or abet therein.
- 22 (b) An individual who holds a license to practice
- 23 professional nursing in this Commonwealth who meets the
- 24 requirements under sections 6.2 and 8.5 of this act to be a
- 25 clinical nurse specialist shall have the right to use the title
- 26 "clinical nurse specialist" and the abbreviation "C.N.S." No
- 27 other person shall have that right.
- 28 (b.1) An individual who holds a license to practice
- 29 <u>professional nursing in this Commonwealth who meets the</u>
- 30 requirements under section 8.8 of this act to be an advanced

- 1 practice registered nurse-certified registered nurse anesthetist
- 2 <u>shall have the right to use the title "advanced practice</u>
- 3 registered nurse-certified registered nurse anesthetist,"
- 4 <u>"certified registered nurse anesthetist" and the abbreviations</u>
- 5 "C.R.N.A." or "A.P.R.N.". No other person shall have that right.
- 6 (c) Notwithstanding subsection (a), this section shall not
- 7 prohibit the use by a person of a descriptive title for nurse
- 8 assistive personnel. For the purposes of this subsection, the
- 9 term "nurse assistive personnel" shall mean an individual
- 10 providing health care services under the supervision of a
- 11 professional or practical nurse.
- 12 Section 3. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
- 13 <u>Section 8.8. Advanced Practice Registered Nurse-Certified</u>
- 14 Registered Nurse Anesthetist; Qualifications. -- (a) The Board
- 15 may certify a licensed registered nurse as an advanced practice
- 16 registered nurse-certified registered nurse anesthetist if the
- 17 nurse satisfies the requirements established by this section.
- 18 Certification of an advanced practice registered nurse-certified
- 19 registered nurse anesthetist by the Board shall expire on the
- 20 same date as the license of that nurse expires. Beginning on the
- 21 effective date of this section, a nurse shall not qualify for
- 22 initial certification by the Board unless the nurse holds a
- 23 master's degree, doctoral degree or post-master's certificate
- 24 from an educational program in nurse anesthesia that has been
- 25 approved by the Board and that prepares graduates to practice as
- 26 an advanced practice registered nurse-certified registered nurse
- 27 anesthetist and:
- 28 (1) holds current national certification as a certified
- 29 registered nurse anesthetist from a Board-recognized national
- 30 certification organization that requires passing a national

- 1 certifying examination in nurse anesthesia; and
- 2 (2) meets all other Board requirements to practice as an
- 3 advanced practice registered nurse.
- 4 (b) A registered nurse who does not have a graduate degree
- 5 required under subsection (a) shall be qualified for
- 6 certification as an advanced practice registered nurse-certified
- 7 <u>registered nurse anesthetist if that nurse:</u>
- 8 (1) meets the educational requirements for certified
- 9 registered nurse anesthetists that were in effect in this
- 10 Commonwealth at the time the nurse completed a nurse anesthesia
- 11 <u>educational program; and</u>
- 12 (2) submits evidence of recertification as a certified
- 13 <u>registered nurse from a Board-recognized national certification</u>
- 14 organization that requires passing a national certifying
- 15 <u>examination in nurse anesthesia.</u>
- 16 (c) As a condition of biennial certificate renewal by the
- 17 Board, an advanced practice registered nurse-certified
- 18 registered nurse anesthetist must:
- 19 (1) Verify that the nurse holds current national
- 20 recertification from a Board-recognized national certification
- 21 organization that requires passing a national certifying
- 22 <u>examination in nurse anesthesia</u>.
- 23 (2) Submit a renewal application to the Board.
- 24 (3) Pay a renewal fee as set by the Board.
- 25 (4) In the two years prior to the certification renewal,
- 26 complete at least thirty (30) hours of continuing education
- 27 approved by the Board, as required under section 12.1 of this
- 28 act.
- 29 <u>(d) For certification under this section, a licensed</u>
- 30 registered nurse shall file a Board-prepared application with

- 1 the Board and pay a fee as established by the Board by
- 2 regulation.
- 3 (e) The Board may issue a certification as an advanced
- 4 practice registered nurse-certified registered nurse anesthetist
- 5 to a licensed nurse who has completed a course of study
- 6 considered by the Board to be equivalent to a course of study
- 7 required in this Commonwealth under section 6.2 of this act and
- 8 this section at the time the course was completed, or who is
- 9 <u>licensed or certified by another state, territory or possession</u>
- 10 of the United States or a foreign country as deemed equivalent
- 11 to Pennsylvania's certification requirements, and who has met
- 12 <u>all the requirements, including character, under this act.</u>
- (f) An advanced practice registered nurse-certified
- 14 registered nurse anesthetist practicing in this Commonwealth
- 15 <u>shall maintain a level of professional liability coverage as</u>
- 16 required for a nonparticipating health care provider under the
- 17 act of March 20, 2002 (P.L.154, No.13), known as the "Medical
- 18 Care Availability and Reduction of Error (Mcare) Act," and shall
- 19 not be eligible to participate in the Medical Care Availability
- 20 and Reduction of Error (Mcare) Fund.
- 21 Section 4. The State Board of Nursing shall promulgate
- 22 regulations to implement the amendment or addition of sections
- 23 2(16), 3 and 8.8 of the act within 18 months of the effective
- 24 date of this section.
- 25 Section 5. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
