AN ACT

1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
2 Consolidated Statutes, in criminal history record
3 information, further providing for information in central
4 repository or automated systems.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Section 9106 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
8 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
9 § 9106. Information in central repository or automated systems.

11 (f.1) Child abuse investigations.--

12 (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter,
13 a criminal justice agency may disseminate information
14 relating to an allegation or instance of child abuse to a
15 county agency or children's advocacy center, as those terms
16 are defined in 23 Pa.C.S. § 6303 (relating to definitions),
17 for the purpose of investigating the allegation or to a
18 multidisciplinary review team, multidisciplinary

1 investigative team or child fatality or near fatality review
2 team for the purposes specified in 23 Pa.C.S. § 6365
3 (relating to services for prevention, investigation and
4 treatment of child abuse).

5 (2) A person who is in receipt of confidential
6 information under this subsection and disseminates the
7 information to a person not specifically authorized to
8 receive the information commits a violation of this section.

9 * * *

10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
