AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 51 (Military Affairs) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, in Department of Military Affairs,
- establishing the Veterans' Outreach and Support Network
- 4 Program.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Title 51 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 9 § 714. Veterans' Outreach and Support Network Program.
- 10 (a) Establishment.--The Veterans' Outreach and Support
- 11 Network Program is established.
- 12 (b) Participants. -- The program may include State agencies,
- 13 county directors of veterans' affairs, veterans service
- 14 organizations, the healthcare provider community and nonprofit
- 15 <u>organizations</u>.
- 16 <u>(c) Purpose.--The program shall:</u>
- 17 <u>(1) Improve the health and well-being of veterans and</u>
- 18 the families of veterans through community engagement and

- 1 consistent network communication.
- 2 (2) Organize participants under subsection (b) to
- 3 cooperate with network partners to provide for proactive
- 4 <u>solutions to address the problems faced by veterans when</u>
- 5 <u>transitioning from military service to civilian life.</u>
- 6 (d) Requirements.--Program requirements shall be determined
- 7 by the department and information shall be disseminated to the
- 8 greatest extent possible on how to best navigate and utilize
- 9 <u>available resources to improve the health and well-being of</u>
- 10 veterans and the families of veterans.
- 11 (e) Duties of department. -- The department shall develop the
- 12 program, which shall contain a mission statement that shall be
- 13 <u>clearly communicated to network partners and participants under</u>
- 14 <u>subsection (b). The department shall:</u>
- 15 (1) Coordinate with other State agencies, county
- directors of veterans' affairs, veterans service
- 17 organizations, the healthcare provider community and non-
- 18 profit organizations, identified by the department, that
- 19 <u>provide programs and services to veterans and the families of</u>
- 20 veterans.
- 21 (2) Provide a Welcome Home to Pennsylvania packet to
- 22 participants.
- 23 (3) Provide information regarding programs, resources,
- 24 training opportunities, veteran service organizations and
- 25 services available to be utilized by family and friends of
- veterans who can regularly interact and offer outreach and
- 27 support for veterans.
- 28 (4) Coordinate with county directors of veterans'
- 29 <u>affairs by providing information of veterans who request</u>
- 30 support through the Veterans' Registry.

- 1 (5) Utilize the address found on the copy of the
- 2 <u>veteran's DD214 forwarded to the department by the United</u>
- 3 <u>States Department of Defense to contact the veteran to send</u>
- 4 <u>out the welcome packet to participate and join our veteran</u>
- 5 network.
- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
