## AN ACT

1	Amending the act of December 5, 1936 (2nd Sp.Sess., 1937
2 3	P.L.2897, No.1), entitled "An act establishing a system of unemployment compensation to be administered by the
4	Department of Labor and Industry and its existing and newly
5	created agencies with personnel (with certain exceptions)
6	selected on a civil service basis; requiring employers to
7	keep records and make reports, and certain employers to pay
8	contributions based on payrolls to provide moneys for the
9	payment of compensation to certain unemployed persons;
10	providing procedure and administrative details for the
11	determination, payment and collection of such contributions
12	and the payment of such compensation; providing for
13	cooperation with the Federal Government and its agencies;
14	creating certain special funds in the custody of the State Treasurer; and prescribing penalties," in penalty provisions,
15 16	further providing for recovery and recoupment of
17	compensation.

18	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
19	hereby enacts as follows:
20	Section 1. Section 804 of the act of December 5, 1936 (2nd
21	Sp.Sess., 1937 P.L.2897, No.1), known as the Unemployment
22	Compensation Law, is amended by adding a subsection to read:
23	Section 804. Recovery and Recoupment of Compensation* * *
24	(d) Notwithstanding any other provision of this act, during
25	the proclamation of disaster emergency issued by the Governor on

1	March 6, 2020, published at 50 Pa.B. 1644 (March 21, 2020), and
2	any renewal of the disaster emergency, the department shall not
3	take any action to recoup compensation paid under this act to a
4	person who was not entitled to the compensation between March 6,
5	2020, through sixty (60) days after termination of the disaster
6	emergency unless the compensation was paid to the person because
7	the person made a false statement knowing it to be false, or
8	knowingly failed to disclose a material fact to obtain or
9	increase compensation.

10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 30 days.
