AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania
 - Consolidated Statutes, in employees, providing for visible
- 3 badges required.

- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 53 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 <u>§ 2172. Visible badges required.</u>
- 9 (a) General rule. -- Except as provided in subsection (b), a
- 10 <u>uniformed police officer in a county, city or other municipality</u>
- 11 <u>must visibly display a badge, tag or label clearly identifying</u>
- 12 the officer at all times.
- 13 (b) Exception.--A police officer or other person empowered
- 14 to make arrests in a county, city or other municipality who is
- 15 not in uniform may not be required to visibly display a badge,
- 16 tag or label clearly identifying the individual as an officer or
- 17 other person authorized to make arrests.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
