6	Section 1. Section 5803(i) of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania

8	§ 5803. Asset forfeiture.

10	(i) Authorization to utilize propertyCash or proceeds of
11	property subject to forfeiture under section 5802 and
12	transferred to the custody of the district attorney or Attorney
13	General under subsection (f) shall be utilized by the district
14	attorney or Attorney General for the enforcement of or
15	prevention of a violation of the provisions of The Controlled
16	Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act. In appropriate cases,
17	the district attorney and the Attorney General may designate
18	proceeds from the forfeited property to be utilized by

community-based drug and crime-fighting programs, for school
<u>safety and security efforts</u> and for relocation and protection of
witnesses in criminal cases. Real property may be transferred to
a nonprofit organization to alleviate blight resulting from
violations of The Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and
Cosmetic Act.
