24	(5) MOVEMENT UNDER THIS PERMIT IS NOT AUTHORIZED DURING

27	"fertilizer" shall mean a substance, containing one or more
28	recognized plant nutrients which is used for its plant nutrient
29	content and which is designed for use or claimed to have value
30	in promoting plant growth, except unmanipulated animal manure
