## AN ACT

- 1 Establishing the COVID-19 Vaccine Providers Reimbursement
- 2 Program and the COVID-19 Vaccine Providers Reimbursement
- Account to reimburse COVID-19 vaccine providers for the costs
- incurred in administering the COVID-19 vaccine; and making an
- 5 appropriation.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Short title.
- 9 This act shall be known and may be cited as the COVID-19
- 10 Vaccine Providers Reimbursement Act.
- 11 Section 2. Definitions.
- 12 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 13 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 14 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 15 "Account." The COVID-19 Vaccine Providers Reimbursement
- 16 Account established under section 4(a).
- 17 "COVID-19." The novel coronavirus identified in the
- 18 Governor's proclamation of disaster emergency issued on March 6,
- 19 2020, published at 50 Pa.B. 1644 (March 21, 2020).

- 1 "COVID-19 vaccine." A vaccine for COVID-19 that has received
- 2 an emergency use authorization from the United States Food and
- 3 Drug Administration.
- 4 "Department." The Department of Health of the Commonwealth.
- 5 "Program." The COVID-19 Vaccine Providers Reimbursement
- 6 Program established under section 3(a).
- 7 "Provider." A person or entity authorized to administer the
- 8 COVID-19 vaccine in this Commonwealth by the department.
- 9 Section 3. COVID-19 Vaccine Providers Reimbursement Program.
- 10 (a) Establishment. -- The COVID-19 Vaccine Providers
- 11 Reimbursement Program is established within the department for
- 12 the purpose of reimbursing providers for the costs incurred in
- 13 administering the COVID-19 vaccine.
- 14 (b) Eligible costs. -- The department may reimburse a provider
- 15 under the program to cover the costs associated with
- 16 administering the COVID-19 vaccine, including procuring storage
- 17 units and appropriate refrigeration equipment necessary to store
- 18 the COVID-19 vaccine.
- 19 Section 4. COVID-19 Vaccine Providers Reimbursement Account.
- 20 (a) Establishment. -- The COVID-19 Vaccine Providers
- 21 Reimbursement Account is established as a restricted account in
- 22 the General Fund. Money received by the Commonwealth from the
- 23 Federal Government under the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021
- 24 (Public Law 117-2, 135 Stat. 4) shall be deposited into the
- 25 account. Money in the account shall not lapse or be transferred
- 26 to any other account or fund.
- 27 (b) Appropriation. -- All of the money in the account is
- 28 appropriated to the department for the purpose of reimbursing
- 29 providers under the program.
- 30 Section 5. Administration of program.

- 1 (a) Administration. -- The department shall administer the
- 2 program in accordance with this act.
- 3 (b) Application. -- To apply for a reimbursement under the
- 4 program, a provider shall submit an application to the
- 5 department on a form and in a manner prescribed by the
- 6 department. A provider shall certify all of the following
- 7 information in an application under this subsection:
- 8 (1) The provider was deemed eligible to provide the
- 9 COVID-19 vaccine by the department during the period
- beginning December 1, 2020, and ending March 18, 2021.
- 11 (2) The provider has received an allocation of the
- 12 COVID-19 vaccine from a vaccine manufacturer or the
- department.
- 14 (3) The provider did not receive an allocation of the
- 15 COVID-19 vaccine after March 18, 2021, as a result of section
- 5 of the Order of the Acting Secretary of the Pennsylvania
- 17 Department of Health Directing Vaccine Providers'
- Administration of COVID-19 Vaccines, issued February 12,
- 19 2021.
- 20 (4) The provider is not an agent, employee, subsidiary
- 21 or affiliate of a health care facility on the department's
- 22 COVID-19 focused network provider list.
- 23 (5) The costs incurred in administering the COVID-19
- 24 vaccine.
- 25 (c) Review.--Beginning no later than 30 days after the
- 26 effective date of this section, the department shall review
- 27 applications under subsection (b). No later than 15 days after a
- 28 completed application under subsection (b) is received from a
- 29 provider, the provider shall review and approve or deny the
- 30 application.

- 1 (d) Award of reimbursements.--The department shall reimburse
- 2 providers under the program on a first-come, first-served basis
- 3 until the amount of available funds in the account has been
- 4 completely expended.
- 5 Section 6. Effective date.
- 6 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
